The process will be to make an appeal to the ORP board and exhaust every administrative appeal before filing a lawsuit. At the UAF Faculty Senate meeting the UAFT representative had a fax from the union regarding a notice of intent to file a lawsuit. They have already threatened the next step but run the risk of getting tossed out because they didn't exhaust every remedy. However, the notice of intent to appeal may be part of the process.
