4. Report of the Chair

The Statewide Academic Council met November 17. The Strategic Direction project is moving forward. SAC meets next December 7 in Anchorage. The Board of Regents meets December 8-9 in Anchorage.

- 5. Public or Guest Comments There were no guest or public comments.
- 6. Strategic Direction Update

Paula Donson gave an overview of activities to date.

- Public listening sessions have been held in Eagle River, Mat-Su, Dillingham, and most recently, Interior-Aleutians.
- Formats for these sessions are determined by location, community campus head, and a variety
 of other factors. Sometimes advisory councils are the best audience, sometimes leaders
 gathered at an event for another purpose such as Dillingham works well.
- The format and process for these listening sessions is in the process of evolving as feedback is received about what works and what doesn't.
- Paula Donson will meet with President Gamble next week on the subject of obtaining funds for better PR for these sessions.
- Credit transferability dominates the session topics. The Alaska public believes that credits don't transfer, and university research results to the contrary are not believed.
- The schedule for internal UA listening sessions is in process and will begin in January.
- Minutes and related data, once gathered, will be distributed to the chancellors for sharing and sorting into theme areas at their discretion.
- Anyone can take the on-line survey and all are welcome to do so. Governance is asked to advertise the location of the survey instrument and encourage participation. The survey link is on the Strategic Direction home page at http://www.alaska.edu/shapingalaskasfuture/.
- The Alliance was thanked for being a sounding board for Donson as the process evolves.

Alliance member suggestions:

- Town meetings should be held in Anchorage, Fairbanks, and Juneau that are well publicized and open to all.
- Any additional role of the Alliance in the strategic direction process at this point is unclear and needs to be discussed further.
- It was pointed out that President Gamble had committed that Faculty would be involved in interpreting the outcome of the strategic directions consultation sessions. It was suggested that in order to fulfill this role the minutes and related data should be sent to the members of the faculty alliance as soon as they are ready in order to facilitate timely processing.
