

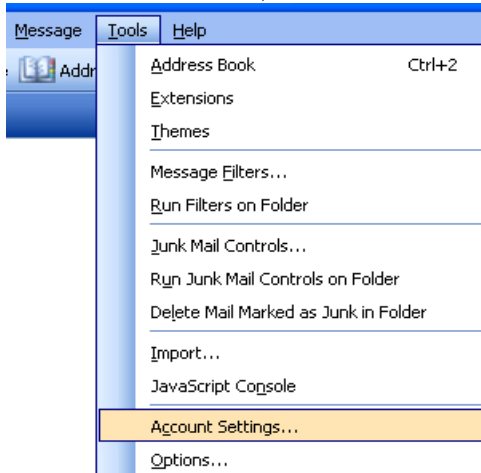
SMTP AUTHENTICATION - MOZILLA THUNDERBIRD

Purpose

This document describes how to modify an existing email account in Mozilla Thunderbird, specifically how to change the outgoing mail server settings to enable outgoing server authentication. It does not describe the entire process of adding email accounts.

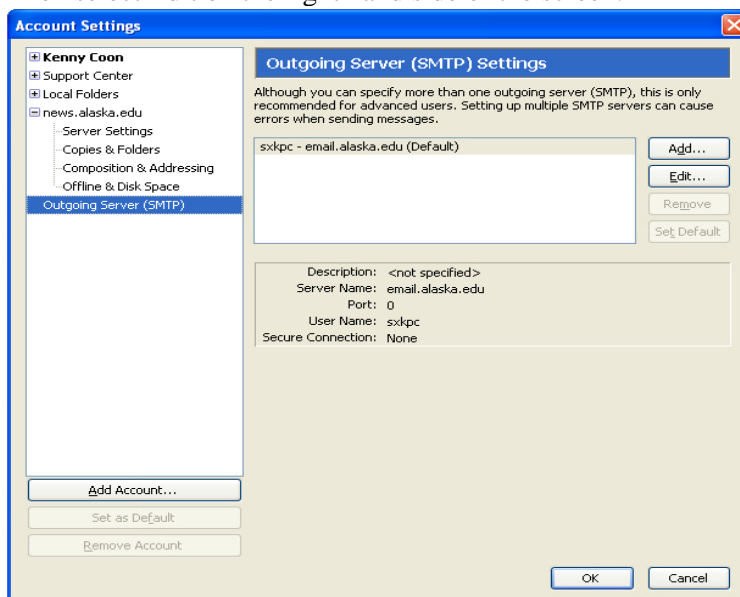
Procedure

1. Open Mozilla Thunderbird
2. From the Tools menu, click on **Account Settings**

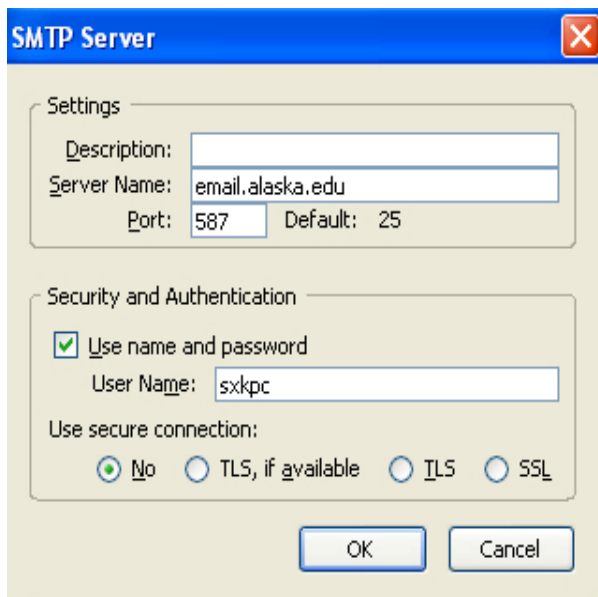


3. On the left side of the screen, scroll down to **Outgoing Server (SMTP)**

Then select Edit on the right hand side of the screen.



- SMTP Server screen will appear. Under the Settings section, change the Port to **587**. Under the section **Security and Authentication**, check the box **Use name and password** and ensure your email user name is entered in the **User Name:** area.



- Click **OK**.
- Click **OK** or **Close** on any remaining setting windows, until you're back to the main screen. You should now be all set to authenticate with the mail server during mail sending.
