Kenai Peninsula College of the University of Alaska Anchorage is proposing the implementation of an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Digital Art. This program builds on the strengths of the Art Department at KPC and the exceptional faculty there, on the history of successful and popular offerings in both photography and art, and on the demand for such courses and programs in the communities served by the college.

This degree program was designed in consultation with faculty in the Department of Art in Anchorage and has received the review and approvals of that department and the UAA College of Arts and Sciences. An active advisory committee is anxious to assist in program implementation and evaluation. Students will be prepared to pursue further study or will qualify for attractive entry-level professional positions in their areas of residence.

This AAS in Digital Art has been approved through the UAA governance process with endorsements from the faculty, Director and advisory committee members at KPC. The proposal was approved by the Undergraduate Academic Board on October 28, 2005 and by the UAA Faculty Senate on November 4, 2005. We ask that you add your review and endorsement to this proposal and forward it to the Regents for approval.
