## POSTER SESSION

Poster presentations provide an opportunity for all conference participants to quickly and easily become acquainted with your research or development topic. This session can cover any topic related to the conference and remote energy in Alaska.

Abstracts that are not accepted for presentation in one of the regular technical sessions may be developed for the Poster Session.

All requests for participation in the Poster Session will be reviewed for appropriateness by the Conference Committee.

### GUIDELINES:

- All Poster Session participants should pay and register for the conference.
- **NO SALES ARE PERMITTED.** This is a technical/research information sharing session only. Exhibitor booths are available. Please see the conference website.
- All presentations must be in English.
- All illustrations, charts, and textual material to be posted must be prepared in advance, since materials for these purposes will not be available at the meeting.
- Poster size is limited to 3' x 4' and may be presented in either landscape or portrait format. All posters should be foam core mounted.
- General Format: Provide a TITLE OF PRESENTATION with the name(s) of the author(s) and affiliation(s) listed below the title. Use large type, and use the same font throughout your poster.
- Authors may wish to bring duplicated copies of their data for handouts. No duplicating facilities will be available at the meeting.
- Displays may be set up after 3pm on September 16<sup>th</sup>. They **must be staffed** during the Poster Session (Wednesday, September 17<sup>th</sup>, 5-8pm) and must be removed by 9pm Wednesday evening.
- All displays and conversations are limited to the assigned area, and may not obstruct the general view or hide other exhibits, and may in no way block any emergency equipment or egress.
