Located in the hub village of Kotzebue in the Northwest Arctic Borough, Chukchi Campus primarily serves Kotzebue, eleven village communities, and the Red Dog Mine. This is a service area of more than 36,000 square miles of spectacular mountain and tundra wilderness.

Chukchi Campus is a two-year public institution with Alaska Native Serving Institution status. We offer a combination of distance delivery modalities, including audio, video, and web-based instruction, as well as face-to-face classes, intensives, and lab practicums. Our in-person courses and programs are offered on campus and at local partner organizations' facilities. We also provide opportunities for students to complete their bachelor's degrees through distance-delivered courses and programs from the larger University of Alaska system, allowing them to stay in the region while advancing their education.


TRANSFORMING EDUCATION TO CAREER OUTCOMES

Graduates of UAF Chukchi campus programs see a positive return on investment, with those graduating between FY17 - FY21 earning an average of \$70,345 annually, about 4 percent (\$2,875) more than they did one year before earning the certificate or degree. This immediate salary boost underscores the effectiveness of UA programs in rapidly enhancing the earning potential of its students while meeting our state's workforce needs.




ENROLLMENT PROFILE

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS AND COMMUNITY IMPACT

Chukchi Campus, located in Kotzebue, Alaska, lies above the Arctic Circle and serves the NANA Region, which spans approximately 36,000 square miles and includes 10 surrounding villages. Its mission is “to be a responsive and collaborative rural college that inspires and develops each student to contribute to the cultural and civic needs of their community.” Chukchi Campus supports students pursuing Occupational Endorsements and Associate degrees, as well as those enrolled in University of Alaska programs working toward bachelor’s, master’s, and PhD degrees. The campus maintains a strong partnership with the Northwest Arctic Borough School District, supporting dual credit and technical education opportunities for high school students. Chukchi Campus is also engaged in the I Love to Speak, Let’s Speak Iñupiaq program in partnership with Aqqaluk Trust. Over the past three years, the campus has collaborated with UAA’s ANSEP program and continues to support participating students.
