Developmental English courses are those with the subject code of DEVE, WRTG, and PREP, with a course number between 050 and 099. Significant Remediation courses are those with course numbers from 050 to 059 and Some Remediation is those courses with course numbers from 060 to 099.

A first-time freshman is a degree seeking student enrolled in the first semester of an undergraduate degree program. Transfer students are not included in this group.
