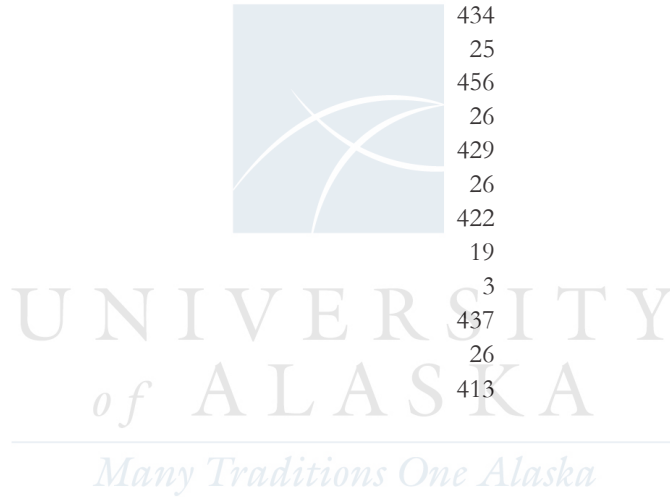

Since the UA Scholar program began in fall 1999, a cumulative total of 8,514 students have enrolled and received a UA Scholar distribution from the University of Alaska, which illustrates the overall impact this program has had on Alaska and its residents.

Note: Developmental courses provide basic or supplemental preparation for introductory college courses and are available in several areas, with those in math and English making up the vast majority of courses taken. To address varying degrees of remediation needed by students, most subjects for which the UA system offers developmental coursework are delivered at two levels: Some Remediation and Significant Remediation. Developmental coursework is not applicable to transcripted certificates or to associate, baccalaureate, or graduate degrees, even by petition. Headcount includes students who audit credit courses. Headcount is unduplicated within each group, e.g. within Developmental English. If a student takes courses at more than one level (e.g. Significant Remediation and Some Remediation) within one group (e.g. Developmental English), then the student is assigned the highest readiness level (e.g. Some Remediation) among the courses he or she took in that group. Developmental math courses are those with the subject code of DEVM or MATH, with a course number between 050 and 099. Developmental English courses are those with the subject code of DEVE, WRTG, and PREP, with a course number between 050 and 099. Significant Remediation courses are those with course numbers from 050 to 059 and Some Remediation is those courses with course numbers from 060 to 099.

A first-time freshman is a degree seeking student enrolled in the first semester of an undergraduate degree program. Transfer students are not included in this group.
