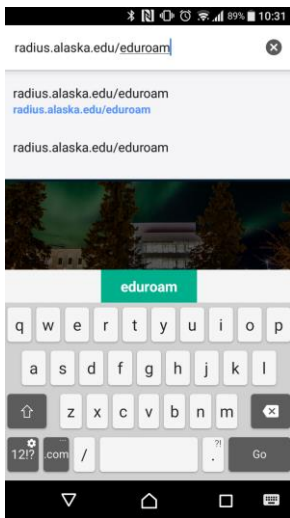




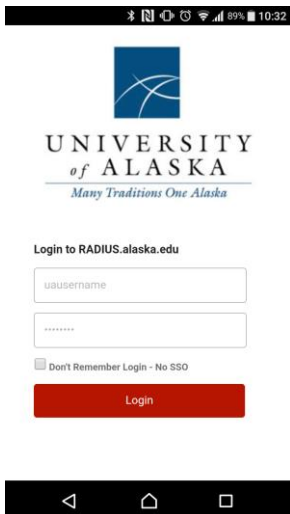
Connecting to Eduroam (Android)

This guide will help you connect to the eduroam Wi-Fi network. Please note that this process is widely different for different versions of Android and may not work for your device. Contact the Service Desk if you experience any issues.

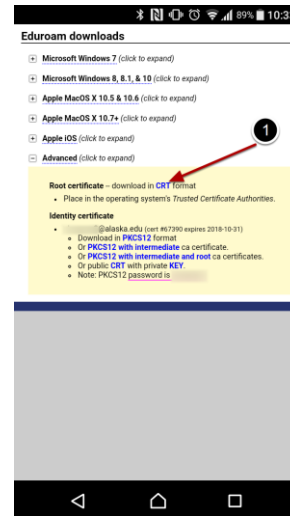
**Use a browser to go to
radius.alaska.edu/eduroam**



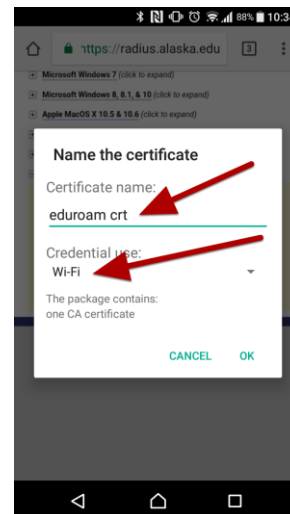
**Login using your UA username and
password.**



**Tap the "+" next to Advanced and
download the Root CRT**

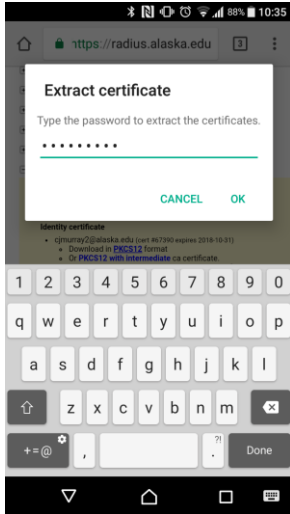


**Name the certificate "eduroam crt"
and select "Wi-Fi" in the Credential
Use field**

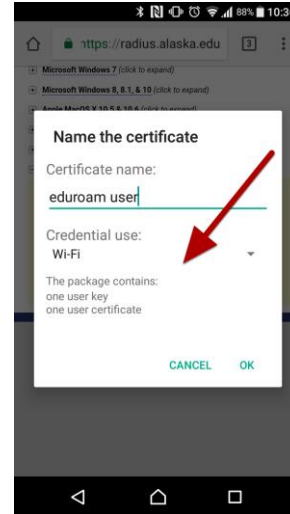


The password to extract the

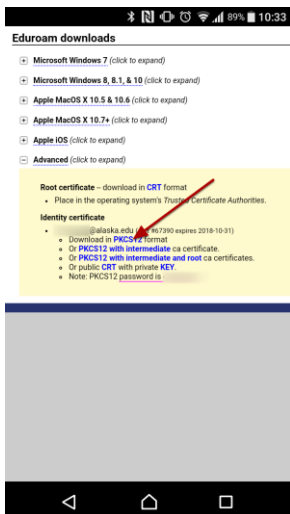
certificate is your username



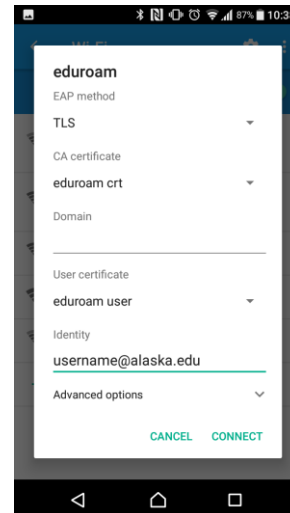
Credential Use field is set to Wi-Fi



Next, download your identity certificate at the PKCS12 link



Go to Settings and then Wi-Fi and select the eduroam Wi-Fi network, configure it as shown below



We suggest naming the certificate "eduroam user" and make sure the

EAP method: TLS

CA Certificate: eduroam crt (or your Root certificate name from above)

User Certificate: eduroam user (or your identity certificate from above)

Identity: your full email address

You are now connected to the eduroam Wi-Fi network
