- a. UAS
  - i. We are still looking for a Faculty Senate President-Elect for next year.
  - ii. We will vote on the change of W dates at our September 5th meeting.
  - iii. We endorsed both resolutions from UAA (AAC&U) and UAF (international students).
  - iv. The committee on Academic Integrity and Excellence furnished their work and has provided the Chancellor with DEI changes on the UAS websites.
  - v. The Course Program of Study issues concerning financial aid was presented at the Senate meeting and more will be coming in August.

#### b. UAF

- i. Trialling putting more "routine" motions on a consent agenda, determined by a vote of the administrative committee
  - 1. Includes transition to directed self-placement for writing
- ii. UAF FS approved resolutions in support of AAC&U Call for Constructive Engagement and in support of the Mutual Aid Defense Compact
- iii. Continued discussion and followup of who should be able to determine who and how many PhD students a department can/must accept; faculty senate endorsed a response from the Graduate Academic and Advisory Committee in response to the chancellor's response to a prior faculty senate resolution, including "Decisions to pause or limit the acceptance of applications based on existing, approved faculty workloads should reside within the realm of those leaders directly managing the program."
- iv. UAF has also been having various discussions of Course Program of Study implications

#### c. UAA

- i. Officers transitions and newly elected Senators were complete.
- ii. UAA FS approved a resolution in support of AAC&U Call for Constructive Engagement.
- iii. UAA FS approved a resolution calling for faculty to include an <u>AI policy statement on</u> syllabi.
- iv. UAA FS distributed <u>Distinguished Service Awards</u> and recognized Emeriti Awards
- v. UAA FS welcomed incoming interim Chancellor Siemers as a guest in May
- vi. Office of Academic Affairs moved forward updated catalog copy for General University Requirements, IB exams, and local credit by exam or portfolio; and expanded language proficiency exams to include Pearson and Duolingo.
