

Faculty Alliance Meeting Notes: 4/23/2021

Paul Layer provided a SW update:

- Paul discussed the middle college bill, reading bills, and accreditation reporting requirements [faculty were concerned about the instructor requirements if a college course was being taught in a HS setting
- Paul discussed TVEP reauthorization and federal and state monies that may be available for the UA system- faculty asked for transparency in the process of receiving funds the and allocation of funds by SW
- Paul discussed the upcoming BOR meetings- education restructure, goals and metrics, budget, funding, legislative issues and asks

FS Updates:

UAA: Diversity Committee reviewed ANSC Resolution and put forth a resolution form UAA, chancellor search underway and President Pitney will make the final discussion soon.

UAS: UAS is working on revising the adjunct form, creating a committee for the Provost search in the fall, Arts and Sciences is searching for a dean. UAS is obtaining feedback on the FA ANSC resolution

UAF: Concerns about targeted faculty, program restructure, athletic consultants, and letters of expectations were expressed; UAF is also obtaining feedback on the FA ANSC Resolution

All three universities have submitted their administrative review reports. SW has yet to finish the review. Survey results from about 50% of those questioned regarding interactions between the universities and SW were obtained. Results will be analyzed. The C and S task force is meeting to finalize the SW review during the summer.

ANSC suggested to UA administration that a College of Alaska Native Languages be created at all three universities to make a home for 23 languages- UAS supported the resolution unanimously during the April meeting. UAA and UAF do not support for the ANSC recommendations. The need to create a School of Alaska Native Languages at UAA and UAS to enable a consortium of schools to create the College of Alaska Native Languages throughout the system- was discussed.
