Resolution 2016-02
Regarding Senate Bill 174

Whereas, Senate Bill 174 (“SB 174”) would prevent the University of Alaska Board of Regents from regulating concealed weapons on university property, inhibiting their response to common, known, high risk and high conflict situations involving concealed firearms and knives on university property; and

Whereas, property owned by the University of Alaska should be treated as a place where safety and security are paramount, similar to government buildings and K-12 schools; and

Whereas, the UAA, UAF and UAS Faculty Senates have all passed legislation or sent communication in opposition of SB 174; and

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, the University of Alaska Faculty Alliance agrees with the actions of the three Faculty Senates; and

Now Therefore Be It Further Resolved, the University of Alaska Faculty Alliance strongly opposes Senate Bill 174.
