STAFF ALLIANCE CONSTITUTION **& BYLAWS**

BASIC RULES RELATING TO SA

IN the CONSTITUTION

- The name of the body
 - (Staff Alliance of the University of Alaska)
- -Where it receives its authority
 - (from the UA BOR)
- Who it communicates with
 - (UA President and Board of Regents)

PURPOSES

- -Opportunity for UA staff to play a meaningful role in matters affecting their welfare
- -Provide consultation to the UA president and BOR
- -Address matters through legislative action
- -Advise the UA president and VPAAR
- -Communication to UA staff information of interest
- -Provide representatives to UA System Governance Council

RESPONSIBILITIES

Include but not limited to:

- -Staff affairs personnel policies and regulations
- -Compensation
- -Benefits
- -Any other issues affecting the work environment and general welfare of university staff

MEMBERSHIP

- -Two representatives from UAA, UAF, UAS, and SW
- -Local groups decide on representative selection
- -Representatives serve a 1-year term (minimum)
- -Any other issues affecting the work environment and general welfare of university staff

OFFICERS

The chair and vice chair are elected annually from current Alliance members. Officers serve a term of one year or until a successor is elected.

MEETINGS

The Staff Alliance is required to meet at least six (6) times per year.

All meetings are open to the public.

QUORUM

A quorum of five members, with at least one member from each campus, will be established in order to conduct business.

PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

The most recent edition of Robert's Rules of Order serves as the parliamentary authority for all Alliance meetings.

REVIEW & TRANSMITTAL The Staff Alliance has forty (40) days to respond to proposals and issues affecting university system staff.

Section I. Officer Duties

Chair: preside over meetings,
 represent the Alliance, and serve as
 primary contact to the UA
 president and Board of Regents

Additional chair duties not in bylaws

- -Write and give governance report at BOR meetings
- Meet monthly with UA president
- Serve on System Governance Council

Section I. Officer Duties

-Vice Chair: fill in if the chair isn't available

Both officers serve on the System Governance Council

Section 2. Meetings

- Public Meeting Notice & Open meetings
- Agendas & Minutes
- Executive Session
- Roll Call Vote
- Meeting Format

Section 3. Quorum

 Voting by proxy is allowed, however, members must notify the chair of their substitution in writing in advance of the meeting.

Section 4. Parliamentary Authority

- Time Limits
- Actions motions and resolutions will be forwarded to the UA president no later than ten (10) days after the meeting

PROVIDING INPUT AND REPRESENTATION ON ISSUES THAT IMPACT STAFF AT UA

COMMITTEES

- Staff Health Care: provide input on the staff
 health care and benefits package;
 communicate to UA staff
- Compensation: provide recommendation on compensation increase to UA president

POLICY & REGULATION REVIEWS

- Review proposed changes or new drafts
- Respond within thirty (30) days
- Can request an additional thirty (30) days

ALLIANCE LEGISLATION – PRESIDENT

- Sent to the president for approval
- President has forty-five (45) days to respond
- Generally consists of approval, rejection, or modification of the Alliance proposal

ALLIANCE LEGISLATION – BOR

- Sent to the BOR for approval
- Regents have ninety (90) days to respond
- Generally consists of approval, rejection, or modification of the Alliance proposal

STAFF MAKE STUDENTS COUNT

- UA President's Staff Award
- Staff members who have made a contribution to the student experience
- Solicitations made by Staff Alliance
- Local groups make award recommendations

SYSTEM GOVERNANCE AT UA

SYSTEM-WIDE GROUPS FOR SYSTEM-WIDE ISSUES

Chapter 03.01 – Faculty, Staff, and Student Governance

REGENTS' POLICY

- Establishes authority of groups

UNIVERSITY REGULATION

- Details specific rules for system and MAU governance

Chapter 02.06 – OPEN MEETINGS REGENTS' POLICY

- Notes UA will conduct open meetings in accordance with Alaska Statute 44.62.310 (Alaska Open Meetings)

UNIVERSITY REGULATION

- Provides parameters for open meeting notices

OPEN MEETINGS

- -Three (3) days notice
- Public online posting
- Held in publically accessible location
- Does not require advance agenda
- Does not require distance participation

UA System Governance is comprised of:

- Staff Alliance
- Faculty Alliance
- Coalition of Student Leaders
- System Governance Council

These groups take up matters that affect the university system as a whole.

STAFF ALLIANCE

- Eight (8) staff representatives
- Two from UAA, UAF, UAS and SW
- -Works on system-wide staff initiatives
- Reviews policy/regulation changes

FACULTY ALLIANCE

- Nine (9) faculty representatives
- -Three from UAA, UAF, and UAS
- -Works on system-wide faculty or academic related initiatives
- Reviews policy/regulation changes


COALITION of STUDENT LEADERS

- -Ten (10) student representatives
- One from each campus: Anchorage, Fairbanks, Juneau, Kachemak Bay, Kenai, Ketchikan, Kodiak, MatSu, Prince William Sound, Sitka
- Works on system-wide student initiatives
- Reviews policy/regulation changes
- Advocates with the legislature

SYSTEM GOVERNANCE COUNCIL

- Nine (9) system representatives
- Two staff, faculty, and student representatives
- Three alumni representatives
- Works on system-wide initiatives that affect multiple groups
- Reviews policy/regulation changes
