

What is the Value of a Postsecondary Education?

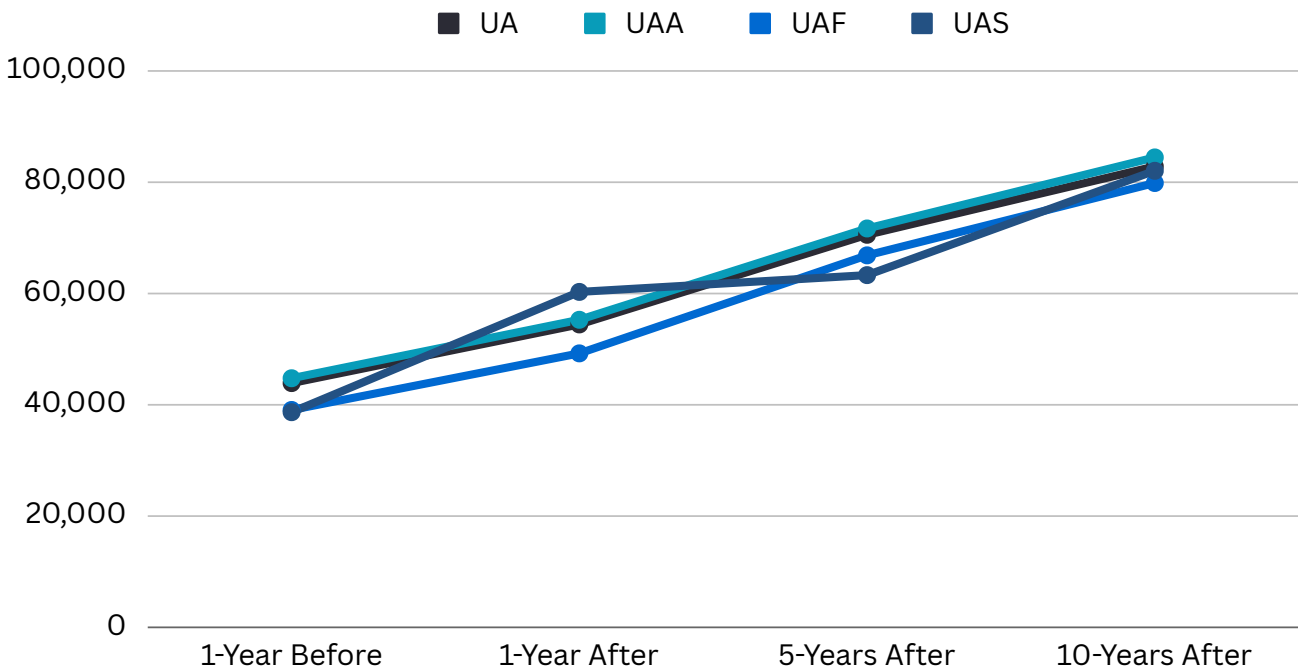
62% percent (20,121 of 32,245) working UA graduates (FY99 - FY21) are working in a field that requires a postsecondary credential.



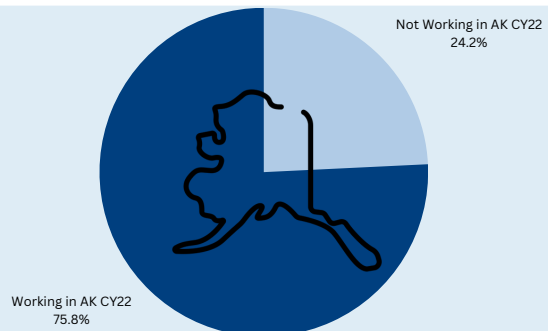
90% Of the 384 known occupations in Alaska in 2022 that require a postsecondary credential, 90 percent (347) employ at least 1 UA graduate.



The Average Annualized Salary for UA Graduates employed in a related field, 1-year before, 1-, 5-, and 10-years after graduation trends up, **reaching an average salary of \$82,843** for all UA graduates 10-years after graduation.

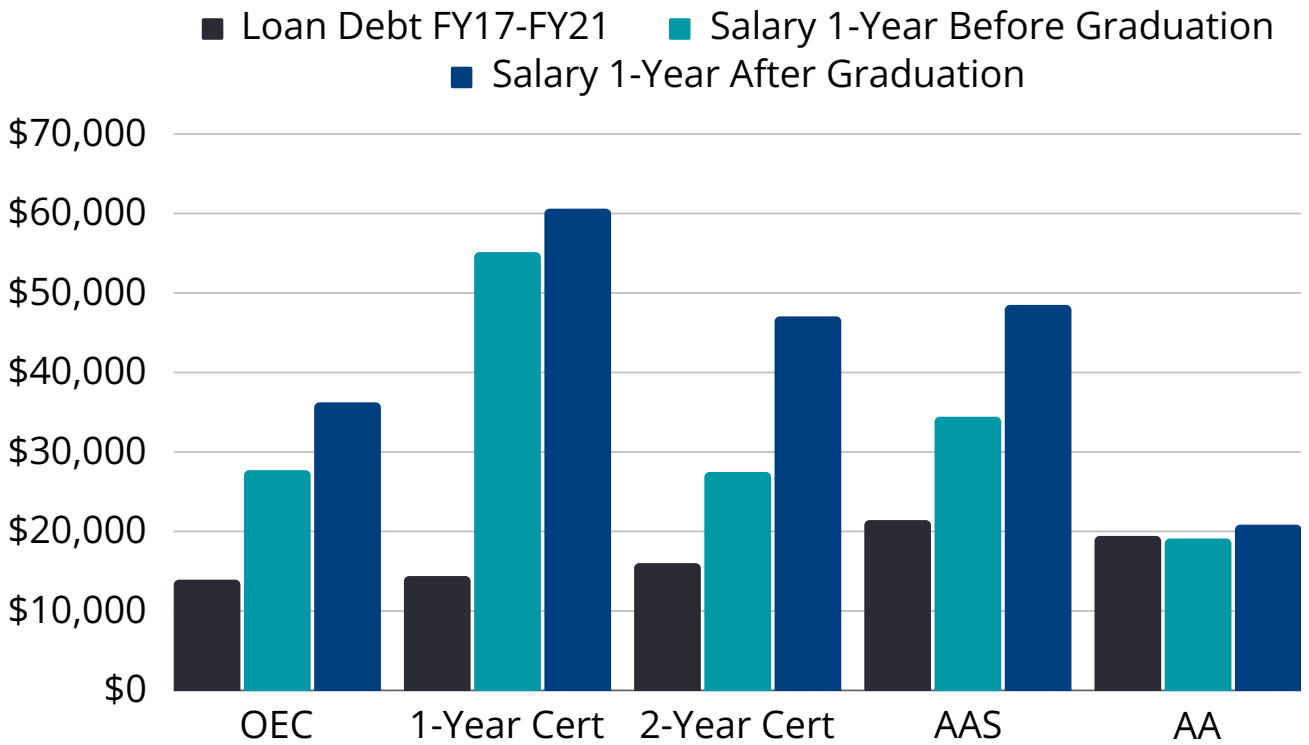


2,995 of **3,980** FY2021 UA Graduates were working in Alaska, in any occupation, 1-year after graduation for an average annualized salary of \$50,266



Outcomes by Degree-Level

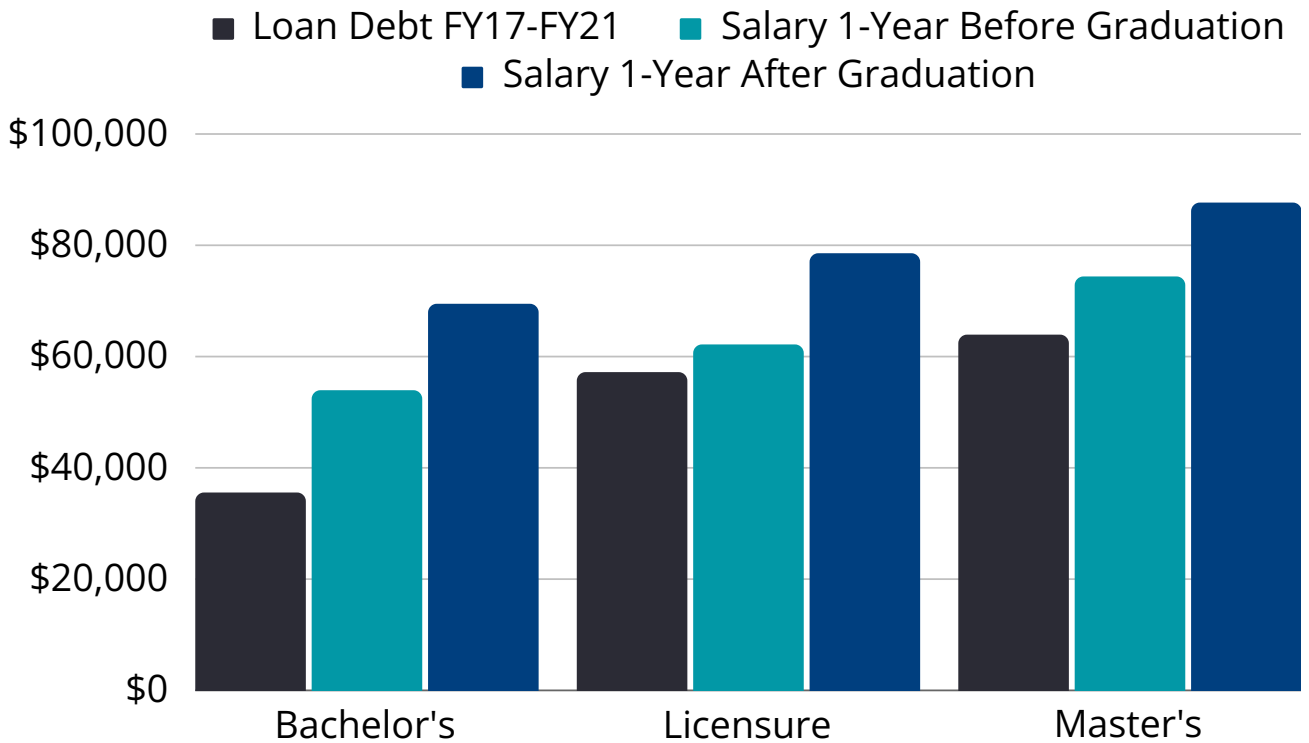
Programs 2-Years and Shorter in Length:



The most recent national graduation rate for students graduating with a certificate or associate's degree within 150 percent of normal time (3 years) at 2-year institutions was 29.3 percent in FY20. In the same fiscal year, UA's graduation rate was 23.6 percent. In FY23 UA's 3-year graduation rate increased to 28.6 percent.

Outcomes by Degree-Level, CONT.

Programs 4-Years and Longer in Length:

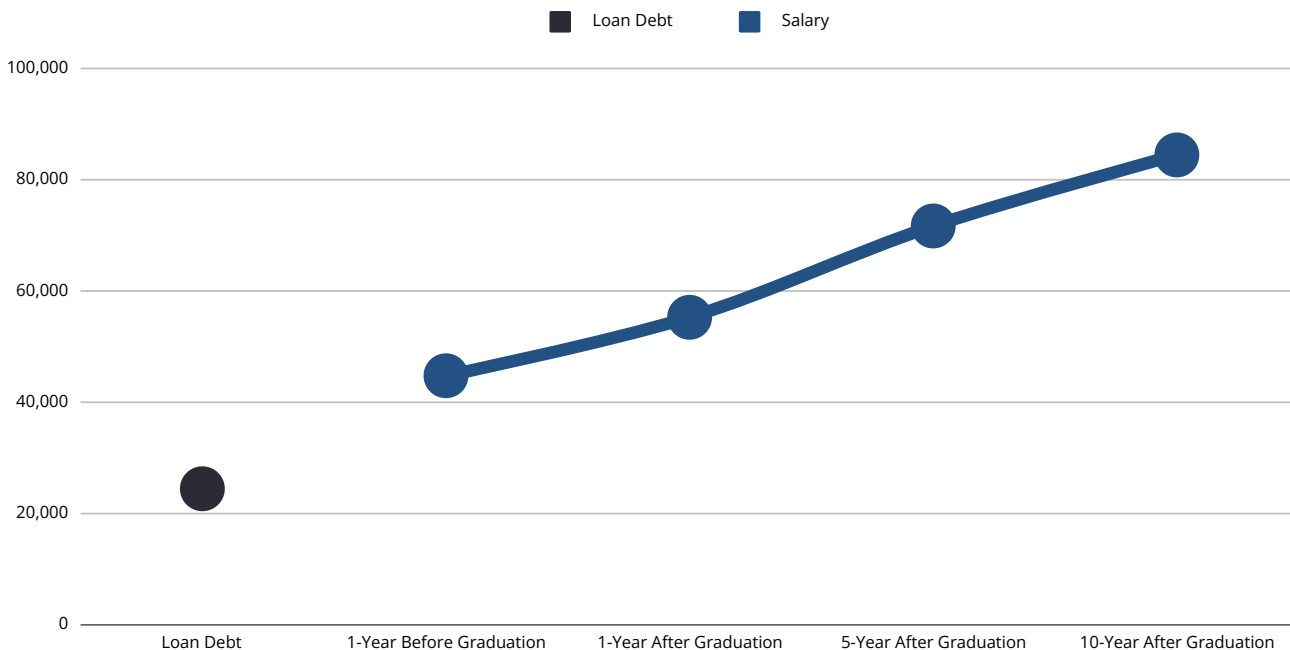


The most recently published national six-year baccalaureate graduation rate for students enrolling at public, four-year, open admission institutions was 28.6 percent in FY20. About 36.9 percent of students pursuing a bachelors degree from UA graduated within six years, 29 percent more than the national average for similar institutions. In FY23 the UA graduation rate was 31.8 percent.

Loan Debt (FY17-FY21 Grads) and Average Annualized Salary for UAA Graduates Employed in Related Field:

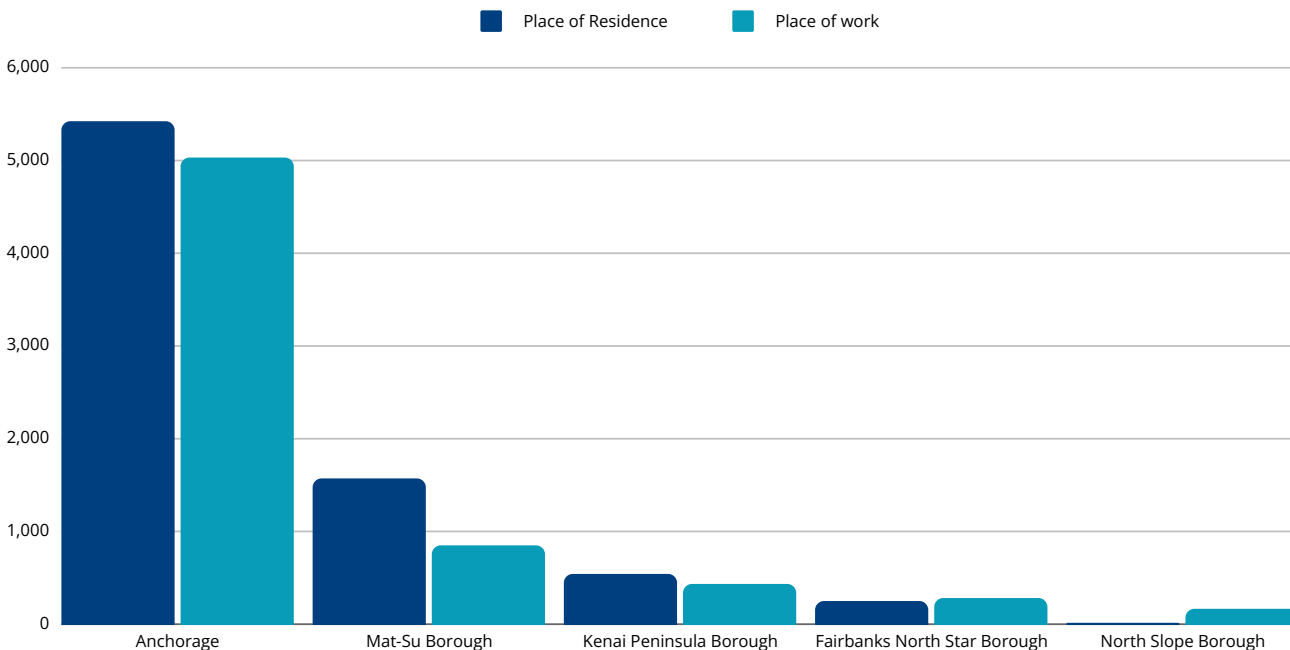


1,601 of **2,075** FY2021 UAA Graduates were working in Alaska, in any occupation, 1-year after graduation for an average annualized salary of \$50,784

The pie chart shows that 77.2% of graduates were working in Alaska (AK) one year after graduation, while 22.8% were not working in Alaska during that period.

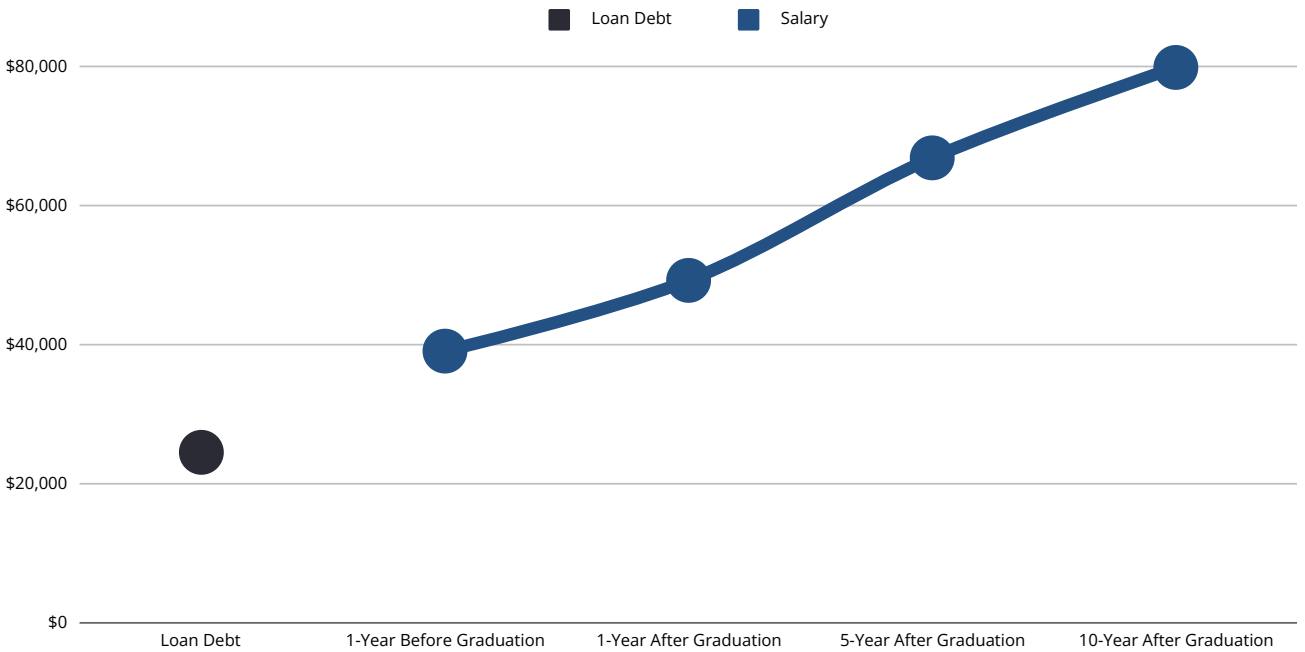

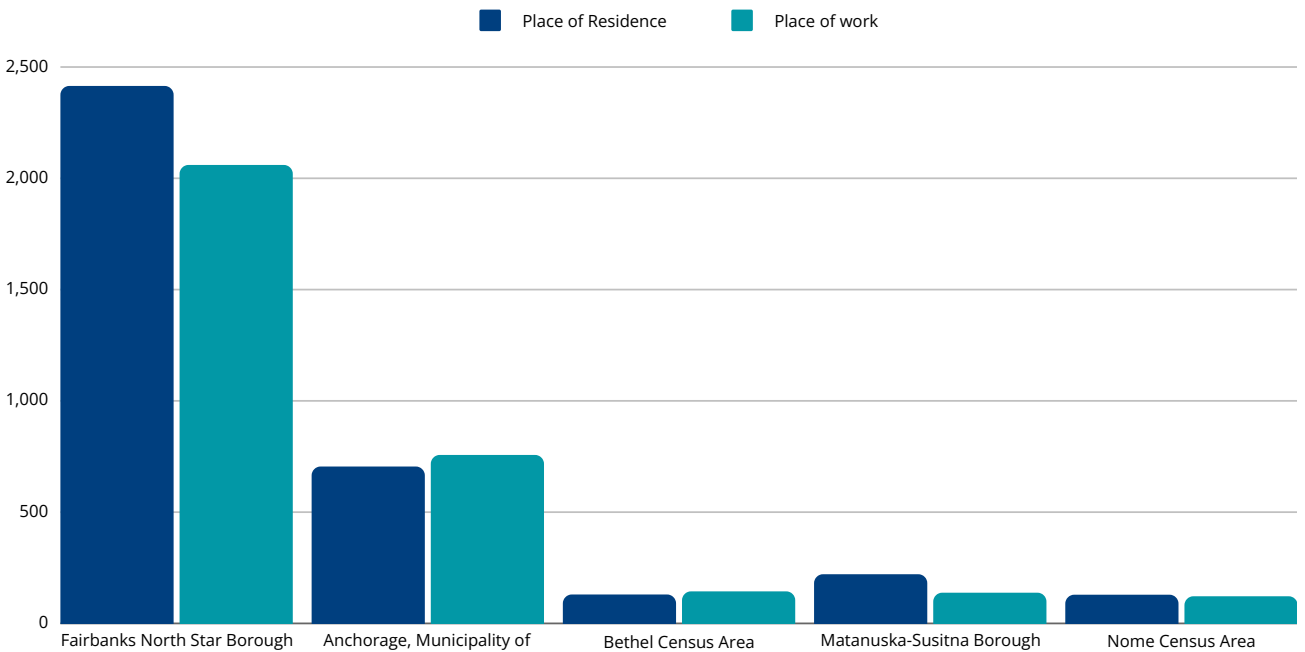
Loan Debt (FY17-FY21 Grads) and Average Annualized Salary for UAF Graduates Employed in Related Field:



892 of 1,327 FY2021 UAF Graduates were working in Alaska, in any occupation, 1-year after graduation for an average annualized salary of \$45,868

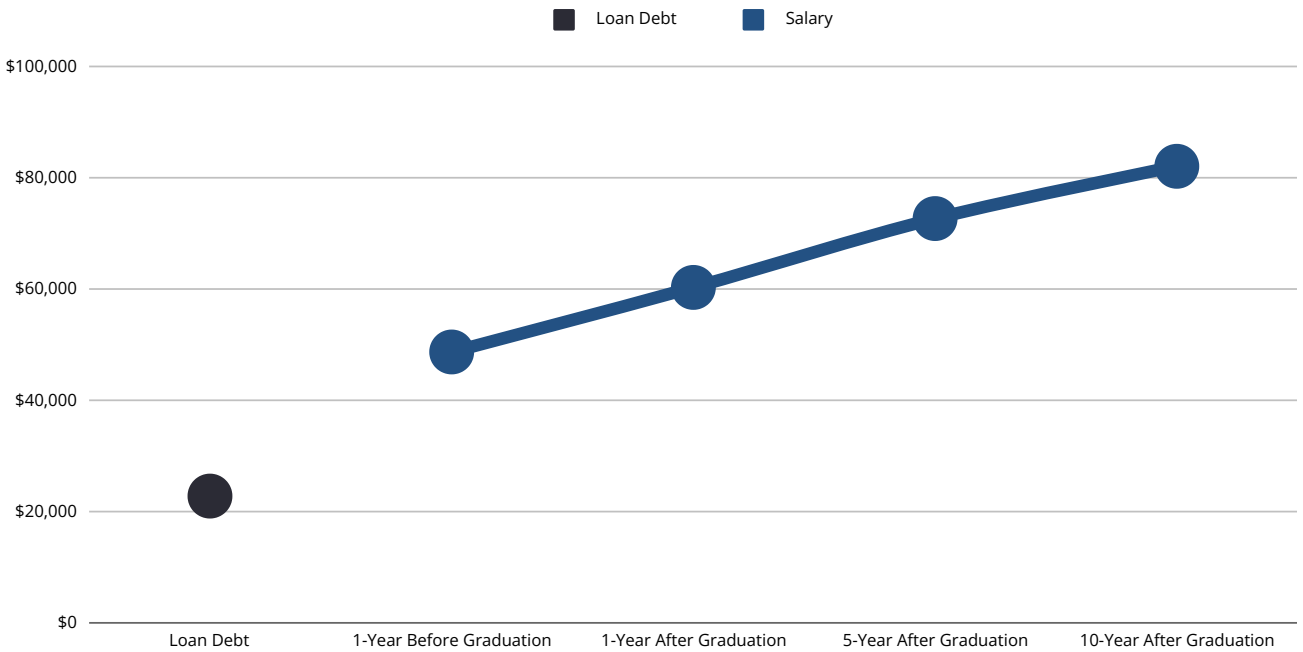

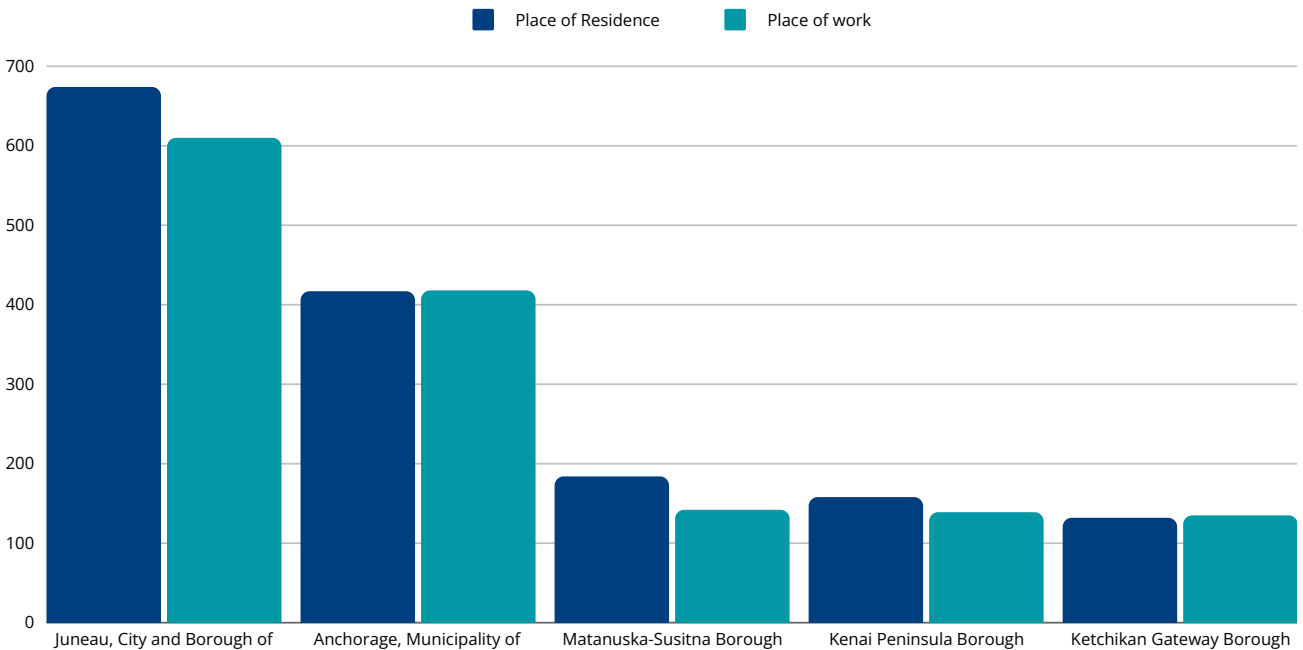
Loan Debt (FY17-FY21 Grads) and Average Annualized Salary for UAS Graduates Employed in Related Field:



502 of 578 FY2021 UAS Graduates were working in Alaska, in any occupation, 1-year after graduation for an average annualized salary of \$56,052

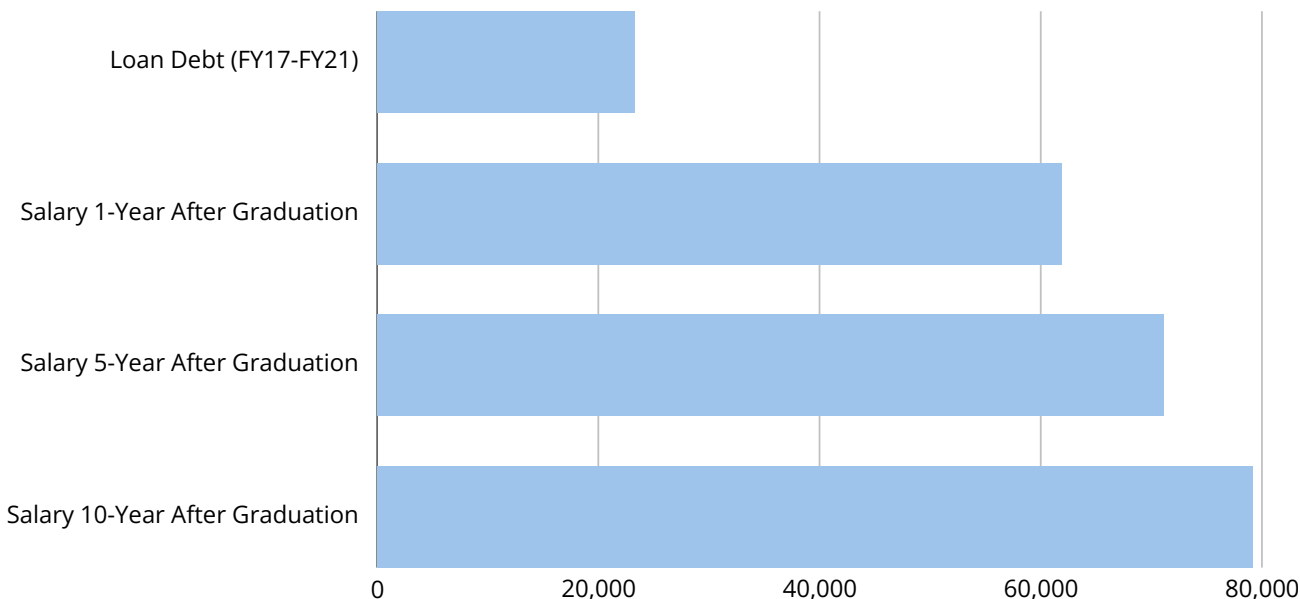

Where are UAS Graduates Working and Living?



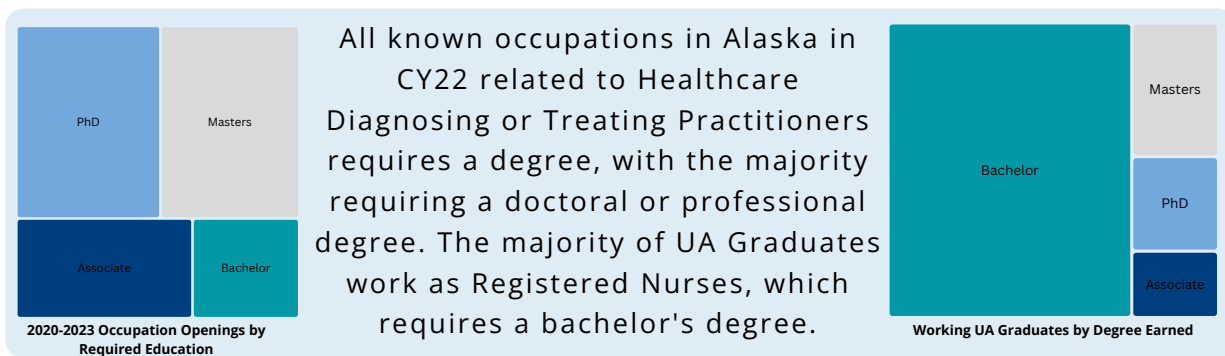
