

# Preliminary Admissions and Course Registration

## Fall 2025 Semester

### Aug 18, 2025

This report compares activity 1 week prior to the first day of instruction for Fall 2025 and Fall 2024 semesters. Information reported here is normalized relative to the first day of instruction for a given term. Fall 2025 semester instruction begins Monday, August 25 and Fall 2024 semester instruction began Monday, August 26.

### **Closing Outlook**

If current trends hold, nearly 20,200 students are anticipated to enroll by the close of Fall 2025, a projected increase of 3 percent (570 students) over Fall 2024. Student credit hour (SCH) registration is anticipated to increase by 5 percent (9,000 SCH), reaching more than 183,700 SCH by the end of the term. Graphs displaying historical and current system level course registration patterns for student headcount and SCH are provided on pages 9 and 10, respectively.

### **Applications**

Over 15,580 applications have been started by prospective students for Fall 2025, up 20 percent (2,636) from Fall 2024. UA Anchorage was up 5 percent (332), and UA Fairbanks increased 44 percent (2,429), while UA Southeast activity decreased 14 percent (119) year-over-year. About 63 percent of applications for Fall 2025 have resulted in admission to a program or course. Of the 9,749 students accepted so far, 44 percent (4,322) have elected to enroll, to-date. This represents an increase of 87 students, year-over-year, in the number of newly admitted students who enrolled.

### **Course Registration**

With two weeks to go before the first day of classes, 17,128 students have registered for 169,247 Fall 2025 semester SCH. Year-over-year this represents a nearly 3 percent growth percent in headcount (486 additional students) and a 5 percent increase in SCH registration (8,290 SCH). About 4 percent of students (680) are concurrently enrolled in more than one university for Fall 2025.

Compared to last year at this time, UAA headcount is up almost 5 percent (442 additional students), and SCH is nearly 7 percent higher (5,894 SCH). See page 2 for additional UAA detail by academic unit.

UAF headcount increased 4 percent (239 students), with students registering in nearly 7 percent more (3,898) SCH year-over-year. See page 3 for additional UAF detail by academic unit.

At UAS, student headcount is nearly 13 percent (219 students) lower and student credit hour registration decreased nearly 12 percent (1,501 SCH) compared to this time last year. See page 4 for additional UAS detail by academic unit.

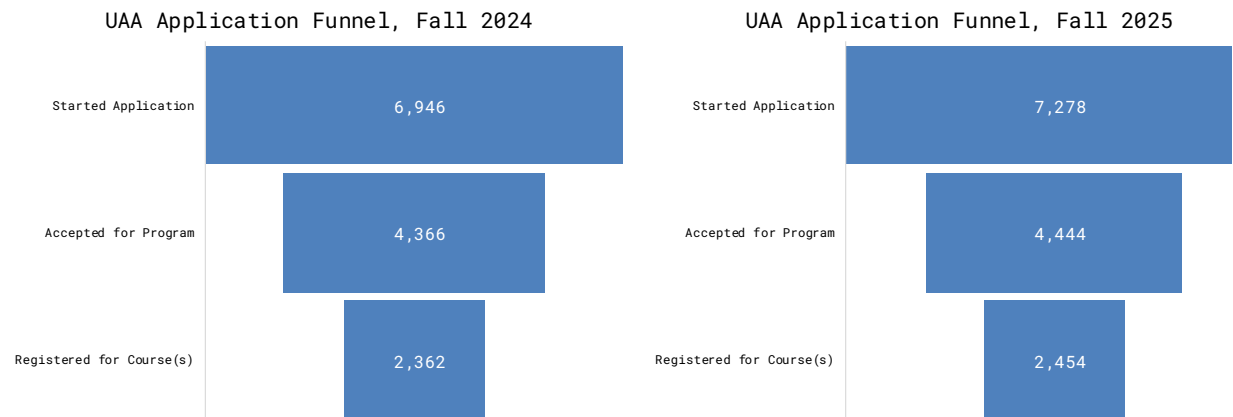

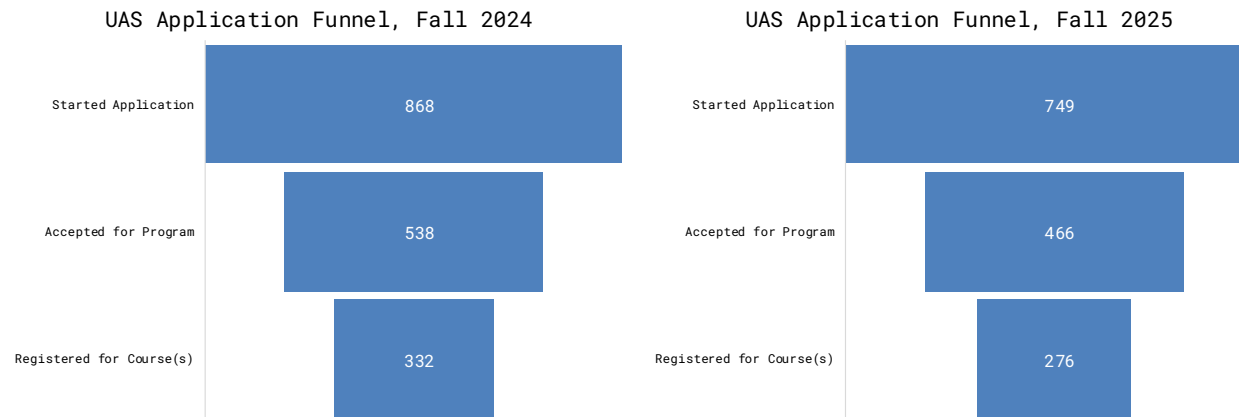

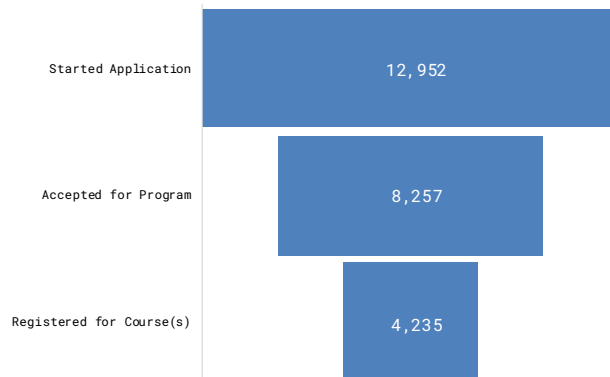

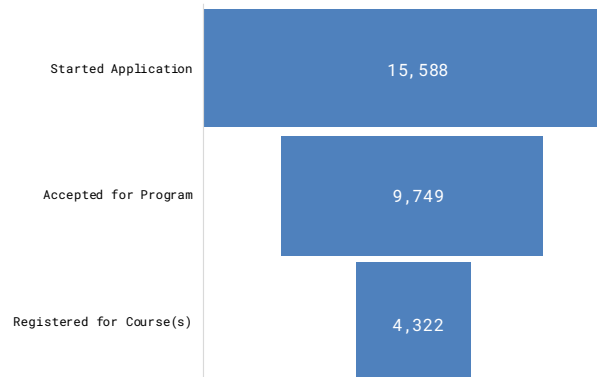

UA Total Application Funnel, Fall 2024



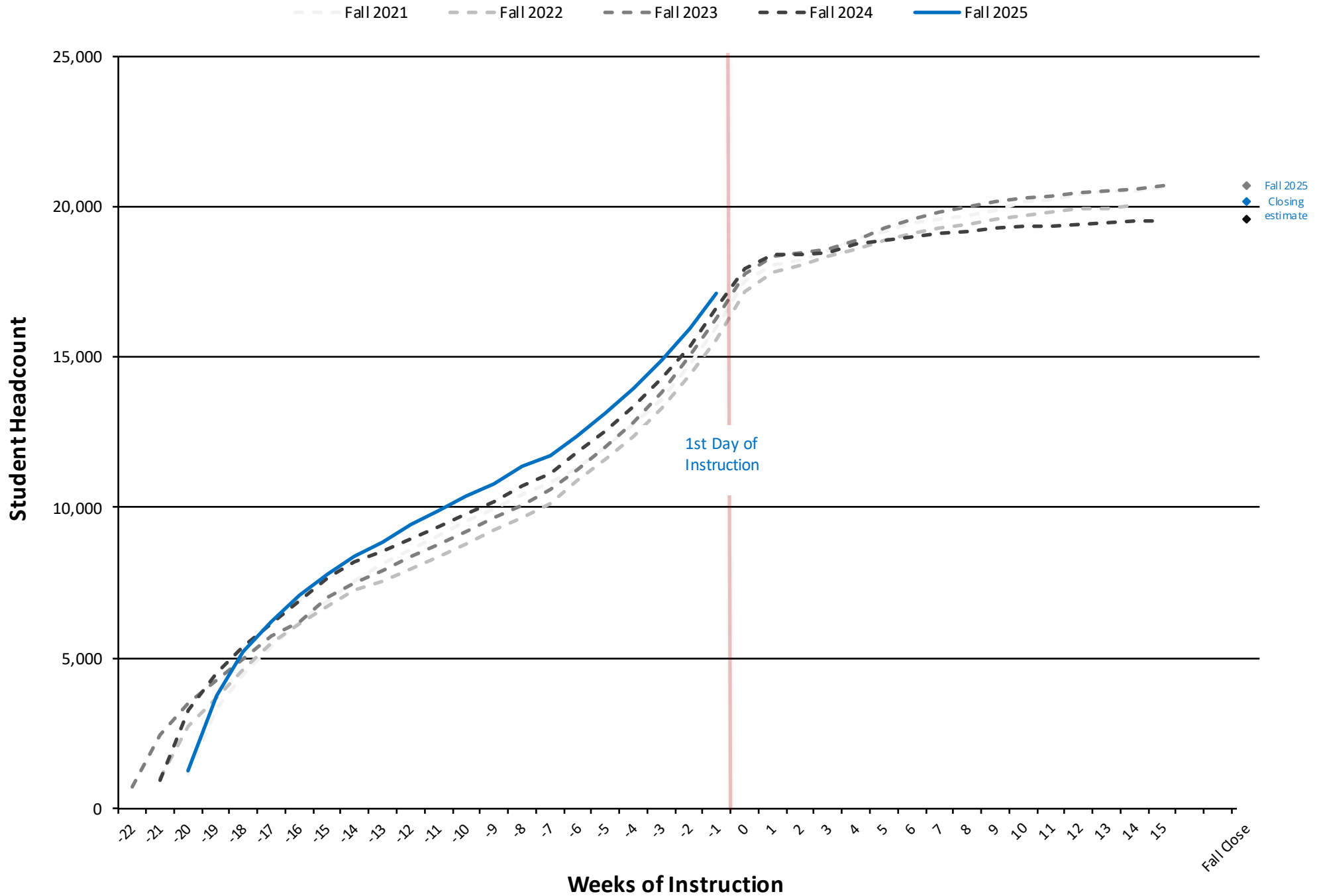
UA Total Application Funnel, Fall 2025
