

Preliminary Admissions and Course Registration
Fall 2025 Semester
Aug 04, 2025

The following is a comparison of student activity 3 weeks prior to the first day of instruction for Fall 2025 and Fall 2024 semesters. Information reported here is normalized relative to the first day of instruction for a given term, to provide accurate trend comparisons and projections at the university and system level. Fall 2025 semester instruction begins Monday, August 25 and Fall 2024 semester instruction began Monday, August 26. Trends are preliminary at this point.

Applications

Over 15,000 applications have been started by prospective students for Fall 2025, up 21 percent (2,578) from Fall 2024. UA Anchorage was up 4 percent (262), and UA Fairbanks increased 45 percent (2,415), while UA Southeast activity decreased 11 percent (90) year-over-year. About 63 percent of applications for Fall 2025 have resulted in admission to a program or course. Of the 9,533 students accepted so far, 38 percent (3,656) have elected to enroll, to-date. This represents an increase of 211 students, year-over-year, in the number of newly admitted students who enrolled.

Course Registration

With a little over a month to go before the first day of classes, 14,927 students have registered for 150,214 Fall 2025 semester student credit hours (SCH). Year-over-year this represents an over 4 percent growth percent in headcount (587 additional students) and a nearly 7 percent increase in SCH registration (9,357 SCH).

Compared to last year at this time, UAA headcount is up almost 5 percent (391 additional students), and SCH is 8 percent higher (6,187 SCH). See page 2 for additional UAA detail by academic unit.

UAF headcount increased over 6 percent (344 students), with students registering in over 8 percent more (4,304) SCH year-over-year. See page 3 for additional UAF detail by academic unit.

At UAS, student headcount is over 10 percent (142 students) lower and student credit hour registration decreased over 10 percent (1,134 SCH) compared to this time last year. See page 4 for additional UAS detail by academic unit.

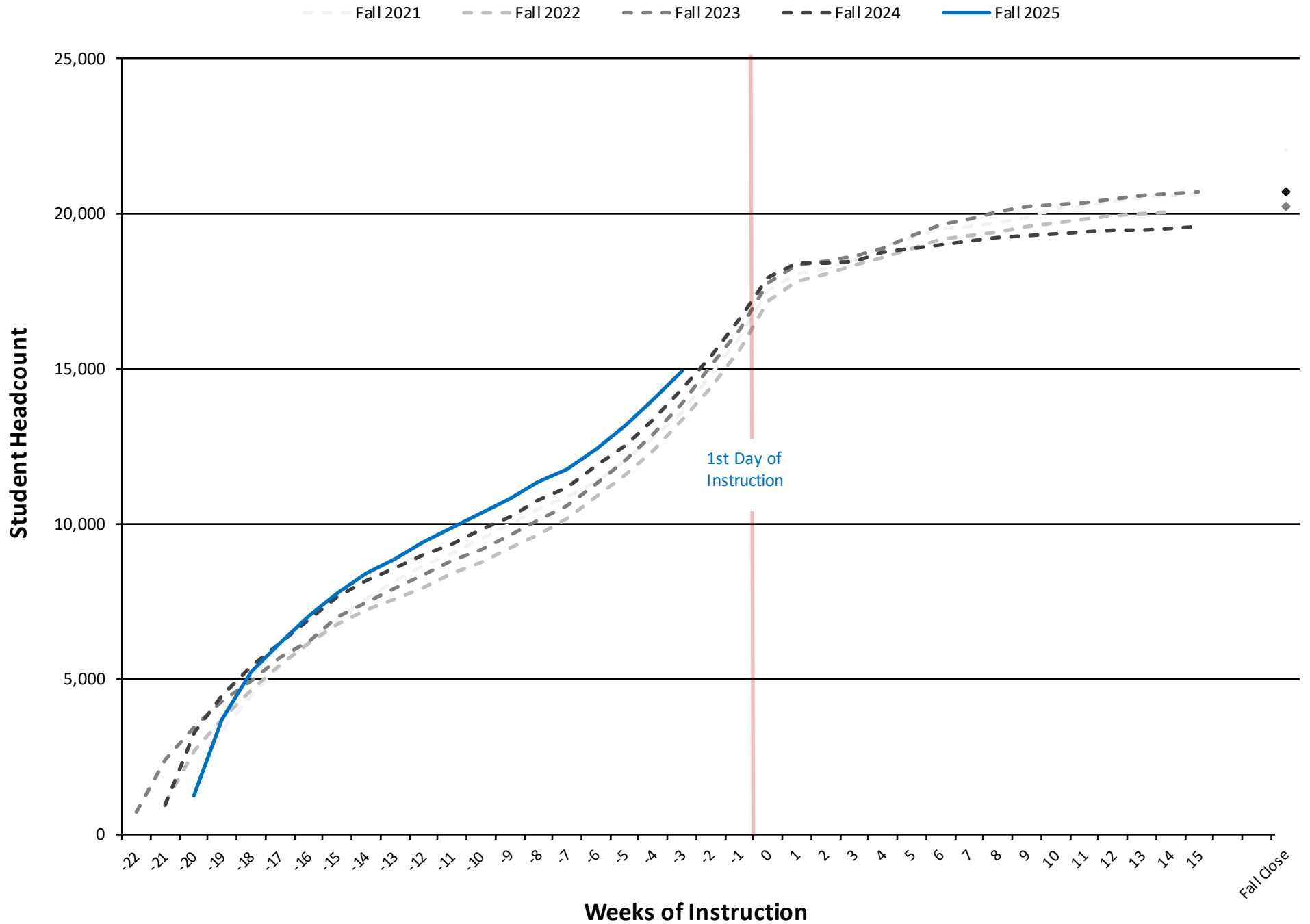
