

Preliminary Admissions and Course Registration

Fall 2025 Semester

July 28, 2025

The following is a comparison of student activity 4 weeks prior to the first day of instruction for Fall 2025 and Fall 2024 semesters. Information reported here is normalized relative to the first day of instruction for a given term, to provide accurate trend comparisons and projections at the university and system level. Fall 2025 semester instruction begins Monday, August 25 and Fall 2024 semester instruction began Monday, August 26. Trends are preliminary at this point.

Applications

Over 14,810 applications have been started by prospective students for Fall 2025, up 21 percent (2,581) from Fall 2024. UA Anchorage was up 4 percent (265), and UA Fairbanks increased 46 percent (2,446), while UA Southeast activity decreased 16 percent (123) year-over-year. About 63 percent of applications for Fall 2025 have resulted in admission to a program or course. Of the 9,280 students accepted so far, 36 percent (3,321) have elected to enroll, to-date. This represents an increase of 176 students, year-over-year, in the number of newly admitted students who enrolled.

Course Registration

With a little over a month to go before the first day of classes, 13,982 students have registered for 141,079 Fall 2025 semester student credit hours (SCH). Year-over-year this represents a nearly 5 percent growth percent in headcount (626 additional students) and a nearly 7 percent increase in SCH registration (8,803 SCH).

Compared to last year at this time, UAA headcount is up almost 6 percent (426 additional students), and SCH is almost 9 percent higher (6,118 SCH). See page 2 for additional UAA detail by academic unit.

UAF headcount increased 6 percent (311 students), with students registering in nearly 8 percent more (3,742) SCH year-over-year. See page 3 for additional UAF detail by academic unit.

At UAS, student headcount is over 9 percent (113 students) lower and student credit hour registration dropped about 11 percent (1,056 SCH) compared to this time last year. See page 4 for additional UAS detail by academic unit.

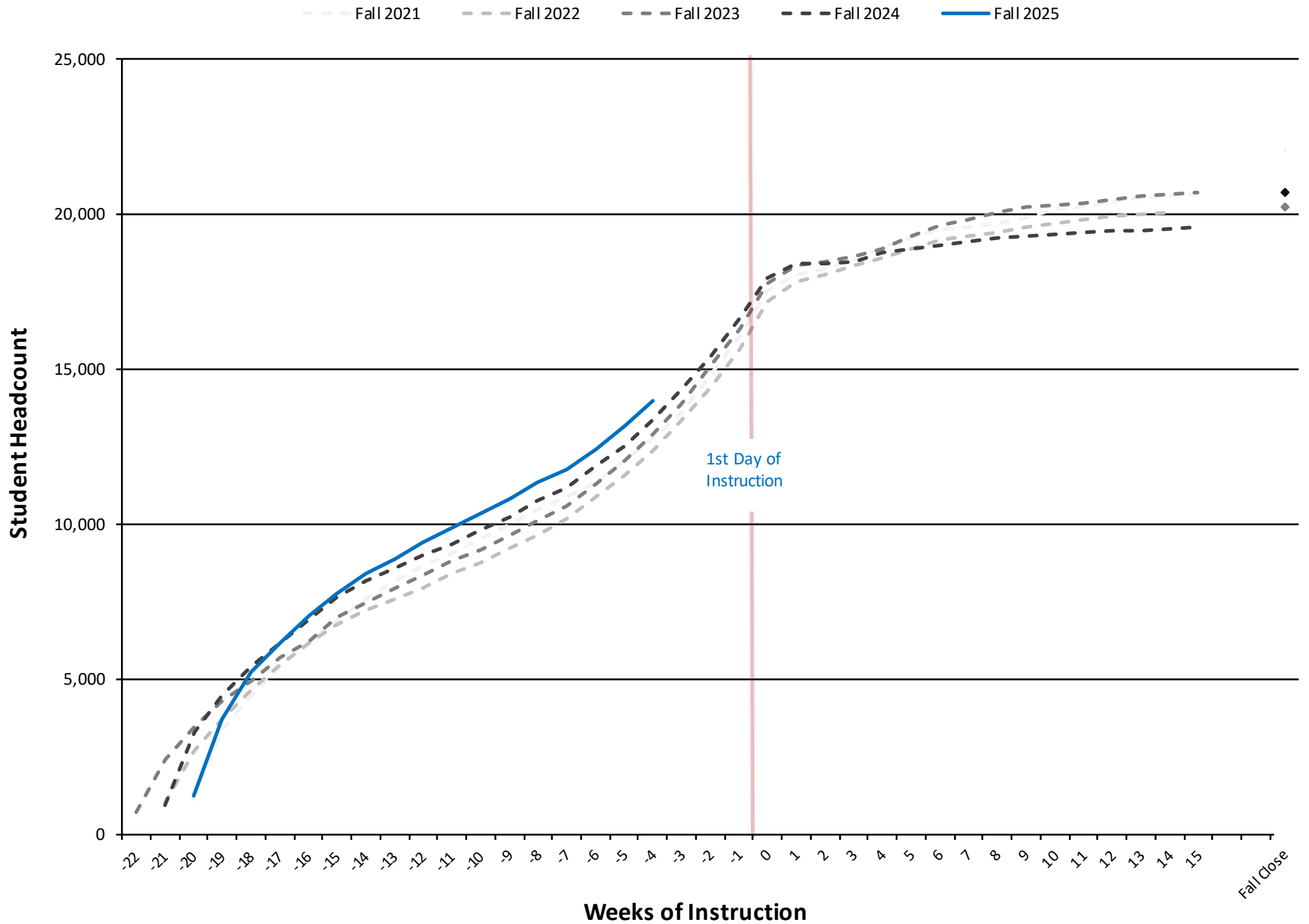
