

# Preliminary Admissions and Course Registration

## Fall 2025 Semester

### Aug 25, 2025

This report compares activity between the first day of instruction for Fall 2025 and Fall 2024 semesters. Information reported here is normalized relative to the first day of instruction for a given term. Fall 2025 semester instruction began Monday, August 25 and Fall 2024 semester instruction began Monday, August 26.

### **Closing Outlook**

If current trends hold, nearly 20,370 students are anticipated to enroll by the close of Fall 2025, a projected increase of nearly 4 percent (750 students) over Fall 2024. Student credit hour (SCH) registration is anticipated to increase nearly 6 percent (10,000 SCH), reaching more than 184,800 SCH by the end of the term. Graphs displaying historical and current system level course registration patterns for student headcount and SCH are provided on pages 9 and 10, respectively.

### **Course Registration**

On the first day of instruction, 18,638 students registered for 181,156 Fall 2025 semester SCH. Year-over-year this represents a nearly 4 percent growth percent in headcount (683 additional students) and an almost 6 percent increase in SCH registration (9,844 SCH). About 4 percent of students (750) are concurrently enrolled in more than one university for Fall 2025.

Compared to last year at this time, UAA headcount is up almost 6 percent (577 additional students), and SCH is nearly 8 percent higher (7,407 SCH). College of Arts and Sciences and College of Health had the largest increase in SCH with a 7 percent increase (2,508), and a 10 increase (1,437), respectively, from Fall 2024. UAF headcount increased roughly 4 percent (266 students), with students registering in over 6 percent more (3,798) SCH, year-over-year. College of Natural Science and Mathematics SCH registration increased 9 percent (1,154), and Bristol Bay Campus SCH registration increased 332 percent (601), year-over-year. At UAS, student headcount is nearly 11 percent (195 students) lower and student credit hour registration decreased over 10 percent (1,361 SCH) compared to this time last year. See page 4 for additional UAS detail by academic unit.

### **Applications**

Over 15,732 applications have been started by prospective students for Fall 2025, up 20 percent (2,673) from Fall 2024. About 63 percent of applications for Fall 2025 have resulted in admission to a program or course. Of the 9,925 students accepted so far, 48 percent (4,761) have elected to enroll, to-date. This represents an increase of 135 students, year-over-year, in the number of newly admitted students who enrolled. 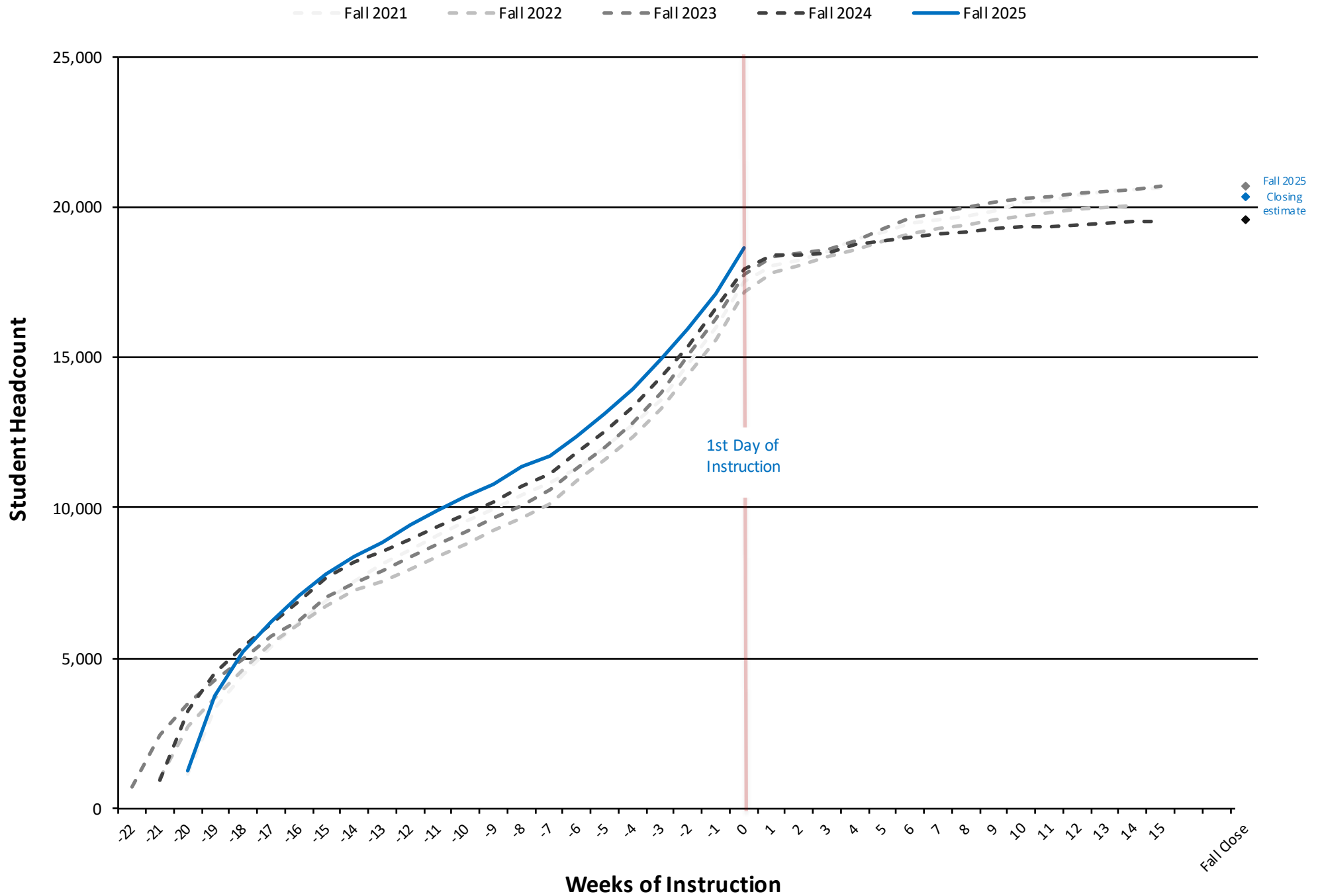
