

Preliminary Admissions and Course Registration

Fall 2025 Semester

Sep 01, 2025

This report compares activity between the second week of instruction for Fall 2025 and Fall 2024 semesters. Information reported here is normalized relative to the first day of instruction for a given term. Fall 2025 semester instruction began Monday, August 25 and Fall 2024 semester instruction began Monday, August 26.

Closing Outlook

If current trends hold, nearly 20,240 students are anticipated to enroll by the close of Fall 2025, a projected increase of nearly 3 percent (610 students) over Fall 2024. Student credit hour (SCH) registration is anticipated to increase nearly 6 percent (9,700 SCH), reaching more than 184,500 SCH by the end of the term. Graphs displaying historical and current system level course registration patterns for student headcount and SCH are provided on pages 9 and 10, respectively.

Course Registration

On the first day of instruction, 18,985 students registered for 183,094 Fall 2025 semester SCH. Year-over-year this represents an over 3 percent growth percent in headcount (575 additional students) and an almost 6 percent increase in SCH registration (9,706 SCH). About 4 percent of students (781) are concurrently enrolled in more than one university for Fall 2025.

Compared to last year at this time, UAA headcount is up almost 5 percent (508 additional students), and SCH is over 7 percent higher (6,975 SCH). College of Arts and Sciences and College of Health had the largest increase in SCH with a 6 percent increase (2,183), and a 10 increase (1,461), respectively, from Fall 2024. UAF headcount increased roughly 3 percent (222 students), with students registering in nearly 6 percent more (3,614) SCH, year-over-year. College of Natural Science and Mathematics SCH registration increased 9 percent (1,136), and Bristol Bay Campus SCH registration increased 265 percent (562), year-over-year. At UAS, student headcount is 9 percent (175 students) lower and student credit hour registration decreased nearly 7 percent (882 SCH) compared to this time last year. See page 4 for additional UAS detail by academic unit.

Applications

Over 15,775 applications have been started by prospective students for Fall 2025, up 20 percent (2,675) from Fall 2024. About 63 percent of applications for Fall 2025 have resulted in admission to a program or course. Of the 9,951 students accepted so far, 48 percent (4,823) have elected to enroll, to-date. This represents an increase of 126 students, year-over-year, in the number of newly admitted students who enrolled. 
