

Preliminary Admissions and Course Registration

Fall 2025 Semester

Sep 15, 2025

This report compares activity between the fourth week of instruction for Fall 2025 and Fall 2024 semesters. Information reported here is normalized relative to the first day of instruction for a given term. Fall 2025 semester instruction began Monday, August 25 and Fall 2024 semester instruction began Monday, August 26.

Closing Outlook

If current trends hold, nearly 20,500 students are anticipated to enroll by the close of Fall 2025, a projected increase of nearly 5 percent (895 students) over Fall 2024. Student credit hour (SCH) registration is anticipated to increase by more than 6 percent (11,140 SCH), reaching more than 185,875 SCH by the end of the term. Graphs displaying historical and current system level course registration patterns for student headcount and SCH are provided on pages 9 and 10, respectively.

Course Registration

On the first day of instruction, 19,309 students registered for 181,510 Fall 2025 semester SCH. Year-over-year this represents an almost 5 percent growth percent in headcount (842 additional students) and a greater than 6 percent increase in SCH registration (10,880 SCH). About 4 percent of students (756) are concurrently enrolled in more than one university for Fall 2025.

Compared to last year at this time, UAA headcount is up 6 percent (612 additional students), and SCH is nearly 8 percent higher (7,256 SCH). College of Arts and Sciences and College of Health had the largest increase in SCH with a 6 percent increase (2,265), and a 10 increase (1,424), respectively, from Fall 2024. UAF headcount increased almost 6 percent (398 students), with students registering in almost 8 percent more (4,617) SCH, year-over-year. College of Natural Science and Mathematics SCH registration increased nearly 10 percent (1,238), and the College of Business and Security Management SCH registration increased nearly 8 percent (569), year-over-year. At UAS, student headcount is 9 percent (186 students) lower and student credit hour registration decreased over 7 percent (993 SCH) compared to this time last year. See page 4 for additional UAS detail by academic unit.

Applications

Over 15,880 applications have been started by prospective students for Fall 2025, up 21 percent (2,746) from Fall 2024. Sixty-two percent of applications for Fall 2025 have resulted in admission to a program or course. Of the 9,918 students accepted so far, 49 percent (4,829) have elected to enroll, to-date. This represents an increase of 248 students, year-over-year, in the number of newly admitted students who enrolled. 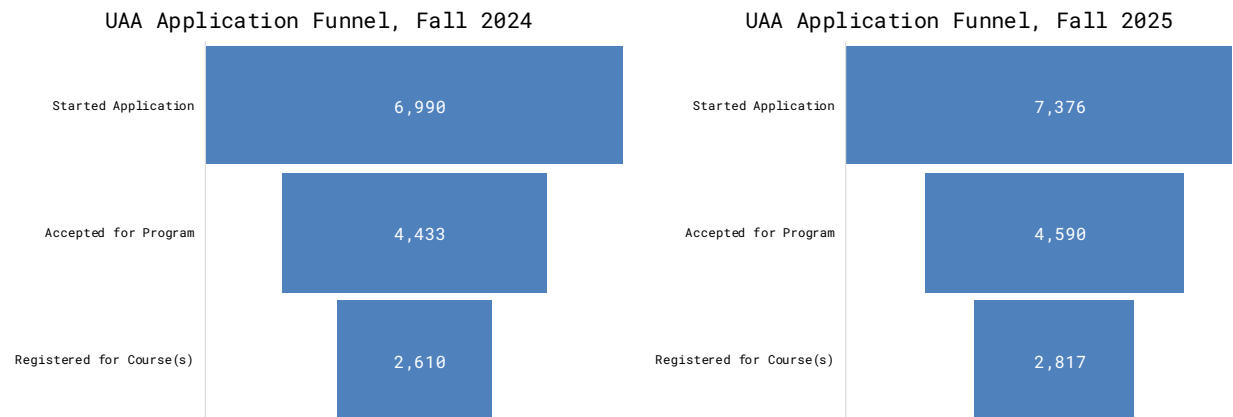

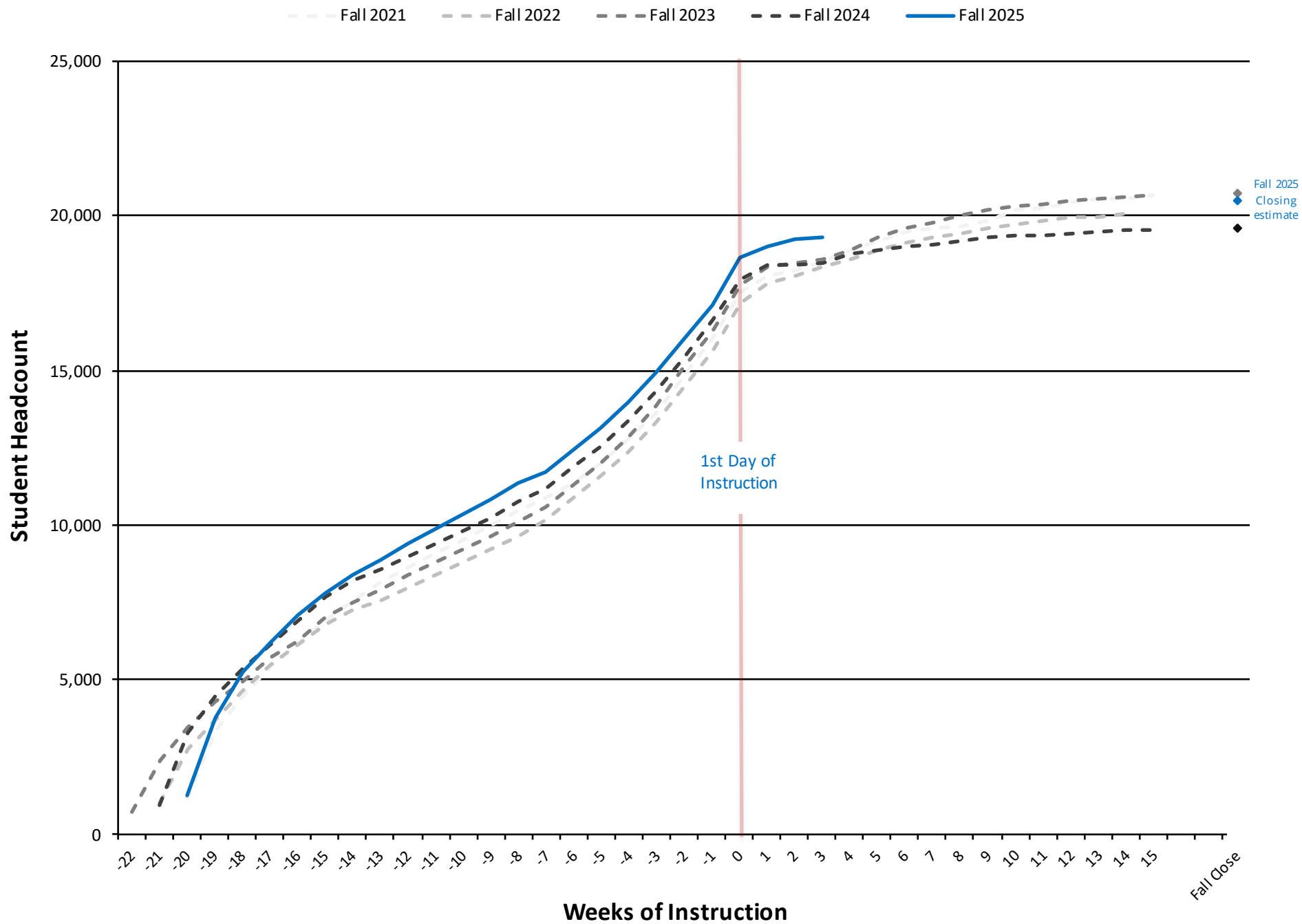
