

# Preliminary Admissions and Course Registration

## Fall 2025 Semester

### Sep 22, 2025

This report compares activity between the fifth week of instruction for Fall 2025 and Fall 2024 semesters. Information reported here is normalized relative to the first day of instruction for a given term. Fall 2025 semester instruction began Monday, August 25 and Fall 2024 semester instruction began Monday, August 26.

### **Closing Outlook**

If current trends hold, nearly 20,500 students are anticipated to enroll by the close of Fall 2025, a projected increase of over 4 percent (870 students) over Fall 2024. Student credit hour (SCH) registration is anticipated to increase by more than 6 percent (10,890 SCH), reaching more than 185,625 SCH by the end of the term. Graphs displaying historical and current system level course registration patterns for student headcount and SCH are provided on pages 9 and 10, respectively.

### **Course Registration**

As of Monday, 19,613 students registered for 182,806 Fall 2025 semester SCH. Year-over-year this represents an over 4 percent growth percent in headcount (835 additional students) and a greater than 6 percent increase in SCH registration (10,724 SCH). Almost 4 percent of students (763) are concurrently enrolled in more than one university for Fall 2025.

Compared to last year at this time, UAA headcount is up 6 percent (637 additional students), and SCH is nearly 8 percent higher (7,315 SCH). College of Arts and Sciences and Matanuska-Susitna College had the largest increase in SCH with a 6 percent increase (2,191), and with an almost 20 percent increase (1,597), respectively, from Fall 2024. UAF headcount increased almost 6 percent (383 students), with students registering in over 7 percent more (4,426) SCH, year-over-year. College of Natural Science and Mathematics SCH registration increased over 9 percent (1,185), and Bristol Bay Campus SCH registration increased over 210 percent (549), year-over-year. At UAS, student headcount is 10 percent (205 students) lower and student credit hour registration decreased nearly 8 percent (1,017 SCH) compared to this time last year. See page 4 for additional UAS detail by academic unit.

### **Applications**

Over 15,800 applications have been started by prospective students for Fall 2025, up 20 percent (2,645) from Fall 2024. Sixty-two percent of applications for Fall 2025 have resulted in admission to a program or course. Of the 9,853 students accepted so far, 49 percent (4,783) have elected to enroll, to-date. This represents an increase of 136 students, year-over-year, in the number of newly admitted students who enrolled. 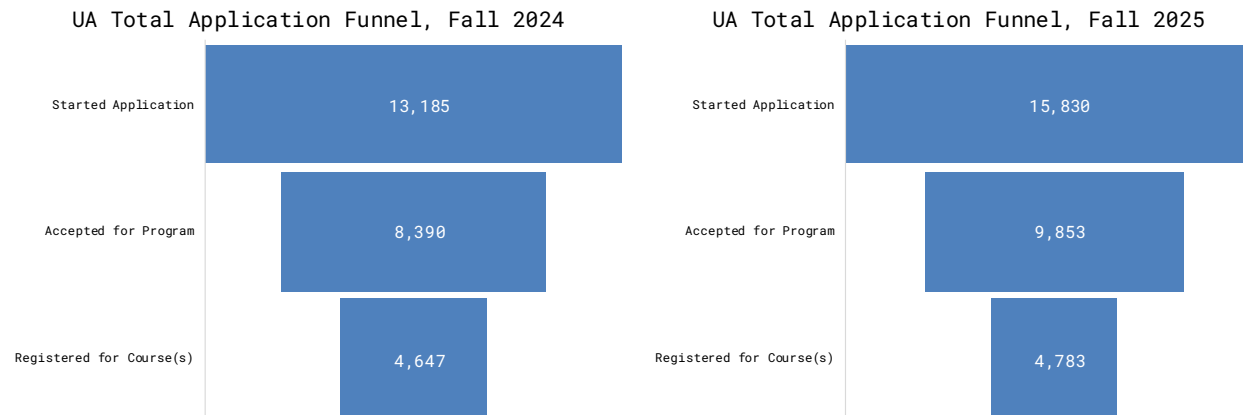

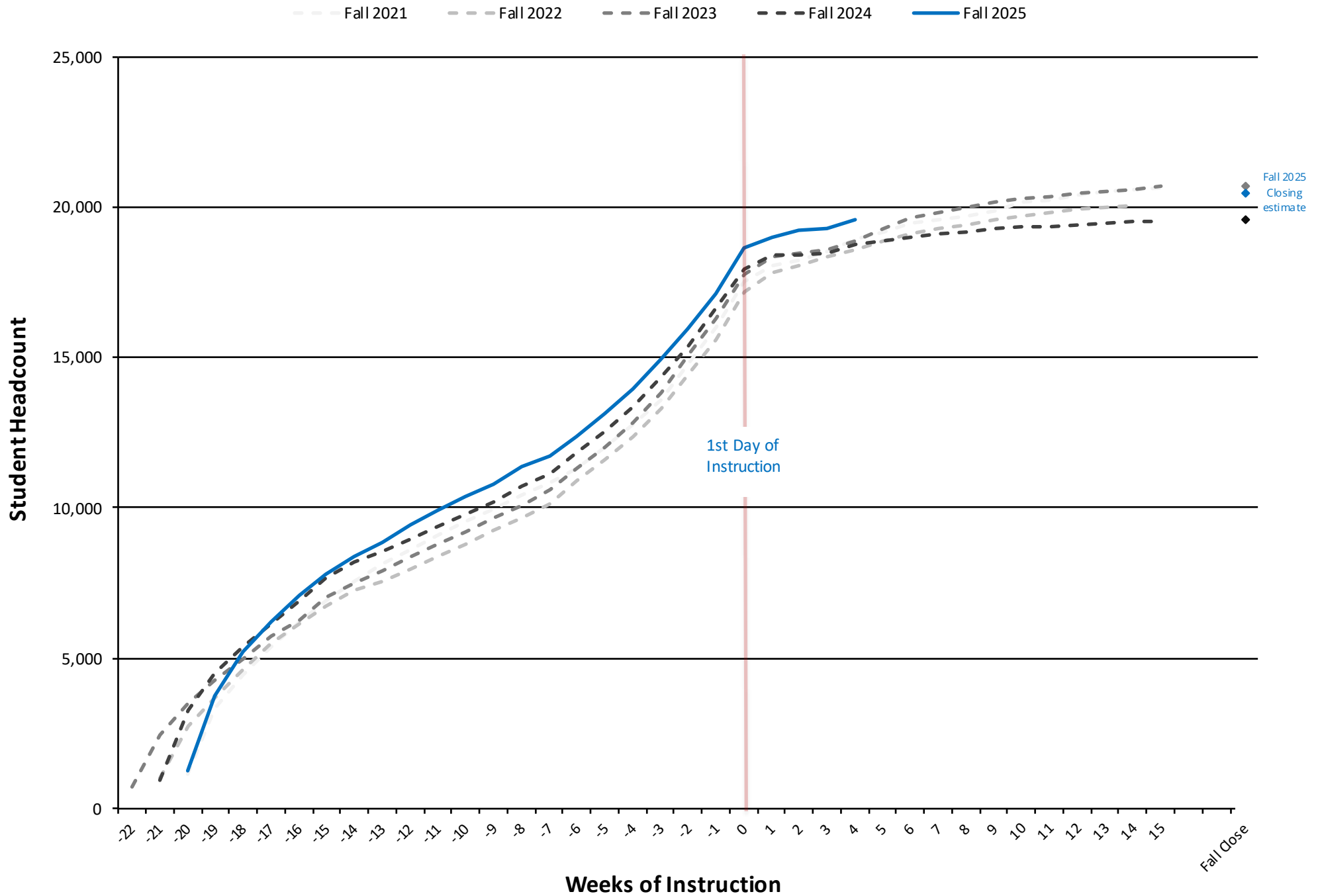
