

Preliminary Applications, Admissions, Enrollment and Revenue Activity  
1 Week Before Start of Fall Instruction  
August 22, 2023

The information below compares preliminary fall 2023 and 2022 semester activity relative to the first day of instruction and provides a working estimate of final fall 2023 closing enrollment levels. The fall 2023 semester starts in 1 week.

At this point, more than three-quarters of all students who will eventually enroll by December have already registered in about 90 percent of fall 2023 student credit hours (SCH). Almost 850 additional students (4 percent) are anticipated to enroll by the end of fall 2023, for a total of about 21,070. Student credit hour registration is also expected to increase by almost 4 percent (6,150 SCH) over last year, reaching nearly 171,000 SCH by the end of term. As of August 21, 2023, 16,287 students registered for 154,371 fall semester credit hours, system wide. This represents a more than 4 percent (661) increase in headcount and a nearly 5 percent (6,947 SCH) increase in student credit hour registration over last year. UAA student headcount is almost 6 percent higher (491 students) and student credit hour registration is about 4 percent higher (3,220 SCH) than last year at this time. UAF headcount increased nearly 6 percent (322 students) and student credit hours increased by almost 8 percent (4,040 SCH) compared to fall 2022. UAS headcount is nearly the same as, and student credit hour registration is about 3 percent lower (313 SCH) than, the level observed one week before the start of fall 2022 instruction. On average across the system, students have registered for more than 9 course credits, potentially generating \$3,550 in tuition and fee revenue. Currently, total net tuition and fee revenue is up more than 6 percent (\$3.3M) system wide over fall 2022. Undergraduate tuition revenue also increased 6 percent (\$2.2M) and graduate tuition revenue increased just over 8 percent (\$0.4M) compared to last year. UAA revenue is up 4 percent (\$1.2M), UAF revenue is up nearly 10 percent (\$2.1M), and UAS revenue is up just over 1 percent (\$49.0 thousand) compared to this time last year. Nearly 11,300 applications have been initiated by prospective students for admission in fall 2023, up almost 13 percent (~1,250 applications) from fall 2022. A total of 4,094 admitted program majors have elected to enroll at the university they were accepted into for fall 2023, about 12 percent higher (422 more) than this time last year. First-time, prospective students have initiated 6,078 applications to at least one program for fall 2023; 70 percent of these applications have been completed by the prospective student and accepted for admission. 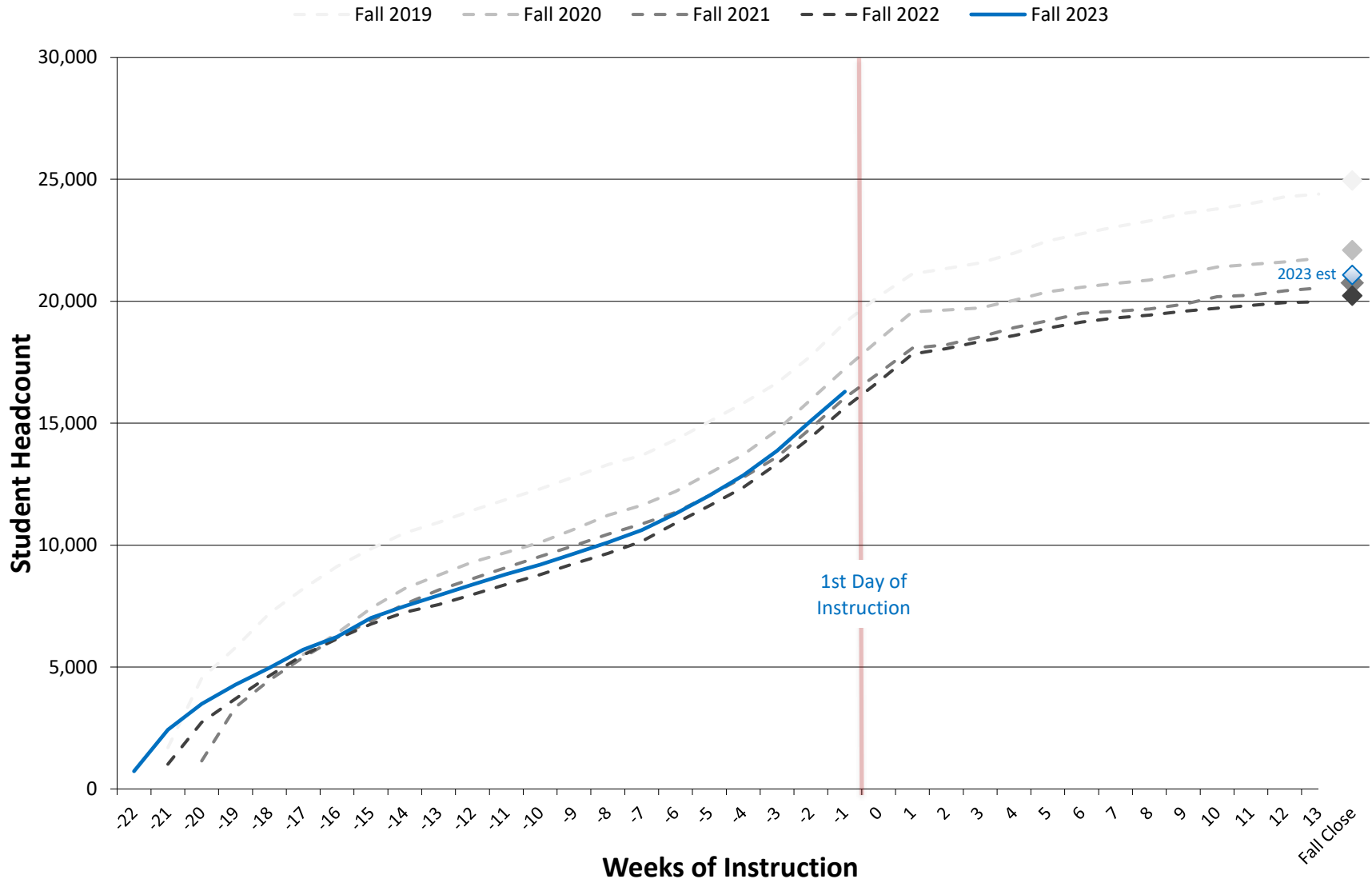
