

Preliminary Admissions and Course Registration
Fall 2025 Semester
Aug 11, 2025

The following is a comparison of student activity 2 weeks prior to the first day of instruction for Fall 2025 and Fall 2024 semesters. Information reported here is normalized relative to the first day of instruction for a given term, to provide accurate trend comparisons and projections at the university and system level. Fall 2025 semester instruction begins Monday, August 25 and Fall 2024 semester instruction began Monday, August 26. Trends are preliminary at this point.

Applications

Over 15,300 applications have been started by prospective students for Fall 2025, up 20 percent (2,567) from Fall 2024. UA Anchorage was up 4 percent (271), and UA Fairbanks increased 44 percent (2,400), while UA Southeast activity decreased 11 percent (95) year-over-year. About 62 percent of applications for Fall 2025 have resulted in admission to a program or course. Of the 9,557 students accepted so far, 41 percent (3,927) have elected to enroll, to-date. This represents an increase of 91 students, year-over-year, in the number of newly admitted students who enrolled.

Course Registration

With a little under two weeks to go before the first day of classes, 15,963 students have registered for 159,165 Fall 2025 semester student credit hours (SCH). Year-over-year this represents a nearly 4 percent growth percent in headcount (573 additional students) and a 6 percent increase in SCH registration (8,977 SCH).

Compared to last year at this time, UAA headcount is up almost 6 percent (502 additional students), and SCH is nearly 9 percent higher (7,029 SCH). See page 2 for additional UAA detail by academic unit.

UAF headcount increased 4 percent (237 students), with students registering in over 6 percent more (3,385) SCH year-over-year. See page 3 for additional UAF detail by academic unit.

At UAS, student headcount is over 12 percent (185 students) lower and student credit hour registration decreased over 12 percent (1,437 SCH) compared to this time last year. See page 4 for additional UAS detail by academic unit.

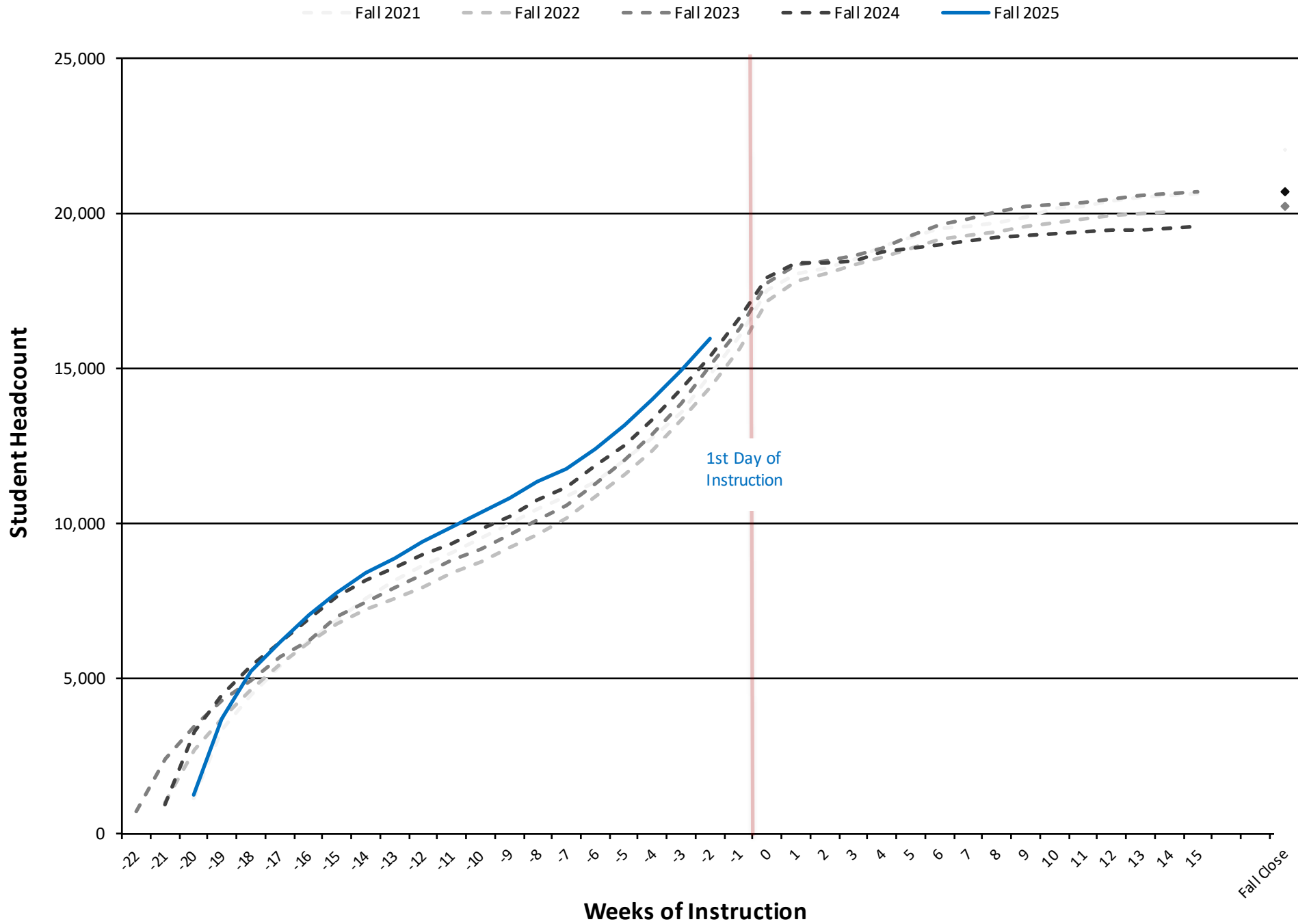
