

Near-Final Spring 2026 Semester Course Registration

April 27, 2026

This report compares near-final Spring 2026 and Spring 2025 semester course enrollment data, year-over-year. These figures reflect all activity for the Spring 2026 semester. Official Spring 2026 semester closing information will be made widely available by the end of May.

Student Headcount

Information entered in Banner as of April 27, 2026 indicates a total of 19,322 students enrolled system wide in Spring 2026, an increase of over 2 percent (405 students) compared with Spring 2025.

Headcount at UAA increased almost 3 percent (298 students), bringing the number of distinct students attending UAA to a total of 10,544 students. Headcount at UAF increased over 1 percent (87 students), reaching a total of 7,437 distinct students enrolled. At UAS, headcount held steady compared to last year.

Over 4 percent of students (797 students) were concurrently enrolled in courses at more than one university during the Spring 2026 semester.

Student Credit Hours

Spring 2026 semester student credit hour (SCH) registration increased almost 5 percent (7,938 SCH) over Spring 2025, reaching a total of 172,766 SCH at the end of the term.

SCH delivered by UAA grew around 6 percent (5,853 SCH), reaching a total of 97,161 SCH. At UAF, SCH increased almost 4 percent (2,353 SCH) with a total of 62,154 SCH. The number of SCH delivered by UAS decreased almost 2 percent (268 SCH) year over year, totaling 13,452 for Spring 2026.
