

# Preliminary Course Registration and Admission Activity, Fall 2026

## 17 Weeks Before Start of Instruction

April 27, 2026

The following is a comparison of student activity 17 weeks prior to the first day of instruction for Fall 2026 and Fall 2025 semesters. Information reported here is normalized relative to the first day of instruction for a given term, to provide accurate trend comparisons and projections at the university and system level. Trends presented here may differ from internal, university reports utilizing alternate date comparisons appropriate to institutional needs.

Fall 2026 semester instruction begins Monday, August 24 and Fall 2025 semester instruction began Monday, August 25. Trends are considered very preliminary at this point, with normal business practice refinements also influencing early activity year-over-year. For example, each university opened Fall 2026 course registration fifteen days earlier than for Fall 2025: UAA, March 20, 2026, vs April 4, 2025; UAF and UAS, March 23, 2026, vs April 7, 2025.

### **Admissions**

A total of 14,203 applications have been started by prospective students for Fall 2026, up 24 percent (2,710) from Fall 2025. The number of initiated applications to UA Anchorage was down 13 percent (608), while UA Fairbanks increased 50 percent (3,354), and UA Southeast activity increased 3 percent (14) year-over-year.

About 70 percent of applications for Fall 2026 have resulted in admission to a program or course. Of the 9,977 students accepted so far, 8 percent (821) have elected to enroll, to-date. This represents a 9 percent (66 students) increase in new, enrolled program majors over this time last year.

### **Course Registration**

Current year-over-year course registration trends show double-digit percent increases at some universities, in part reflecting an earlier start to registration this year compared to last year. The magnitude of percent increase for each university is expected to moderate some between now and the start of the semester.

With 17 weeks to go before the start of instruction, 6,811 students have registered for 72,535 Fall 2026 semester student credit hours (SCH). Year-over-year, this represents an almost 10 percent increase in headcount (616 additional students) and an around 12 percent increase in SCH registration (7,529 SCH). Almost 4 percent of students (238) are concurrently enrolled in more than one university for Fall 2026.

Compared to last year at this time, UAA headcount increased over 11 percent (370 students), and SCH was almost 11 percent higher (3,750 SCH). See page 2 for additional UAA detail by academic unit.

UAF headcount increased over 12 percent (317 students), with students registering in around 15 percent more (3,944) SCH year-over-year. See page 3 for additional UAF detail by academic unit.

At UAS, student headcount decreased almost 4 percent (18 students) and student credit hour registration dropped over 4 percent (165 SCH) compared to last year at this time. See page 4 for additional UAS detail by academic unit.

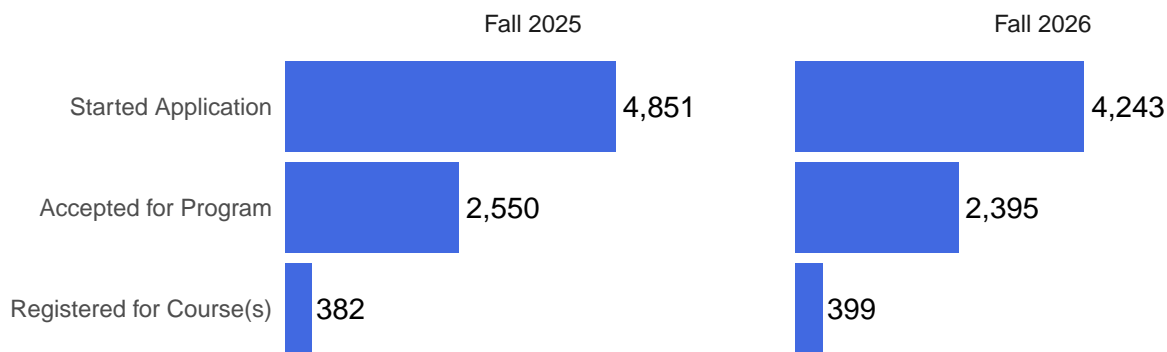

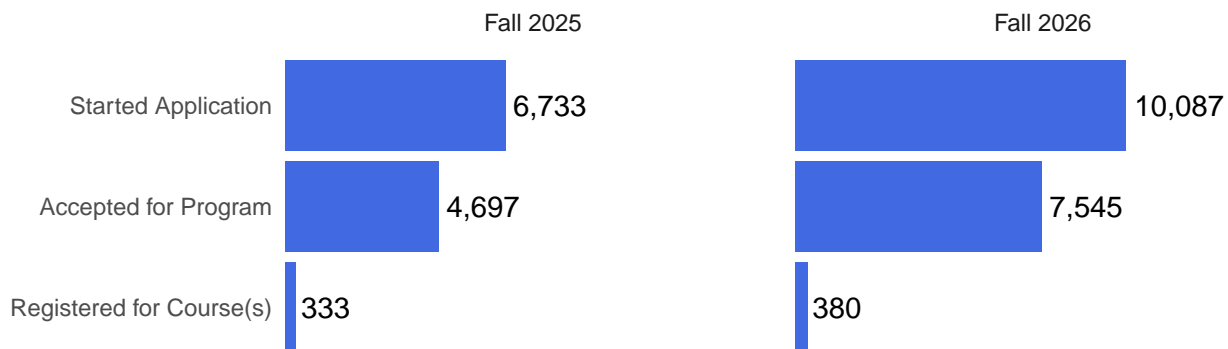

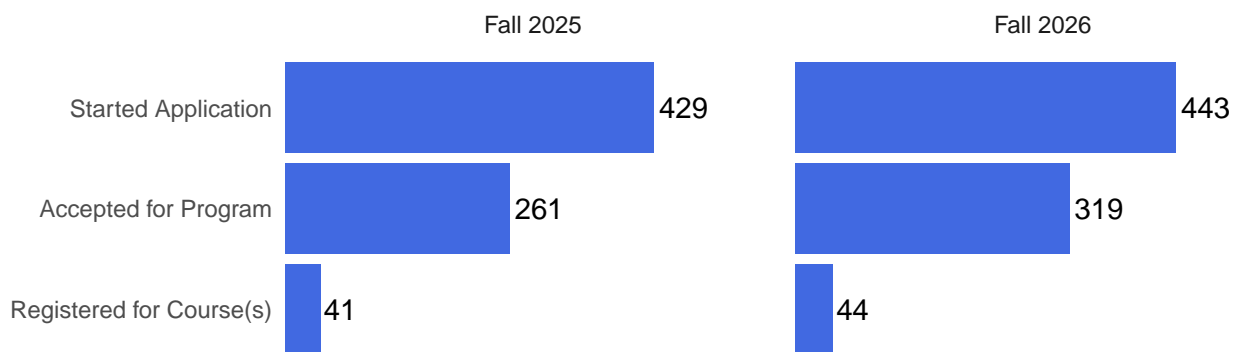

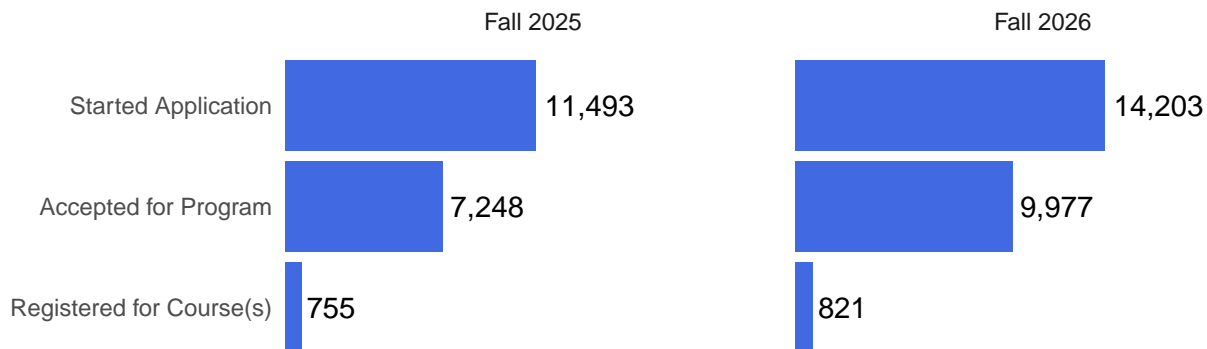

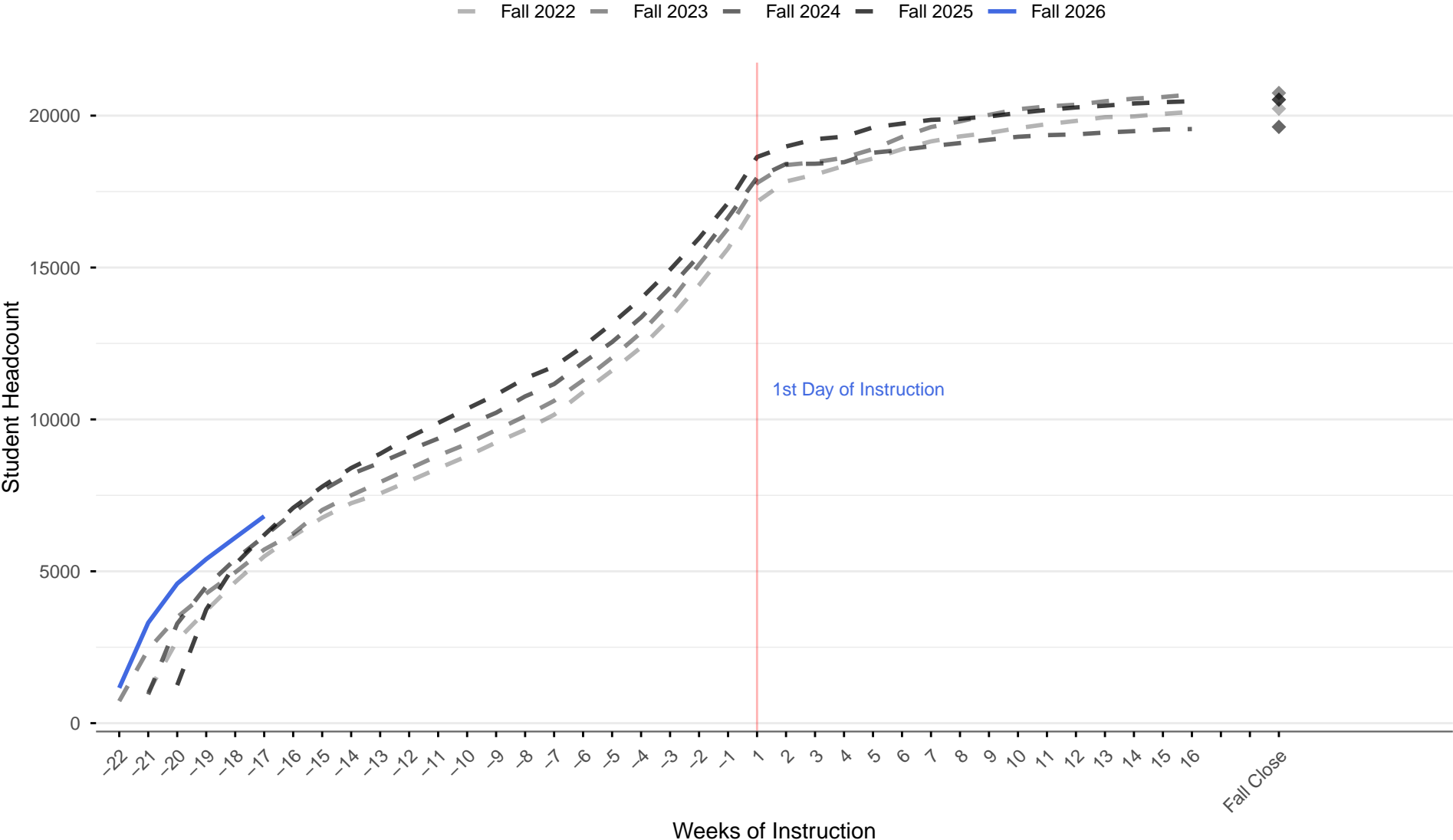
