

# Preliminary Course Registration and Admission Activity, Fall 2026

## 19 Weeks Before Start of Instruction

### April 13, 2026

The following is a comparison of student activity 19 weeks prior to the first day of instruction for Fall 2026 and Fall 2025 semesters. Information reported here is normalized relative to the first day of instruction for a given term, to provide accurate trend comparisons and projections at the university and system level. Trends presented here may differ from internal, university reports utilizing alternate date comparisons appropriate to institutional needs.

Fall 2026 semester instruction begins Monday, August 24 and Fall 2025 semester instruction began Monday, August 25. Trends are considered extremely preliminary at this point, with normal business practice refinements also influencing early activity year-over-year. For example, each university opened Fall 2026 course registration fifteen days earlier than for Fall 2025: UAA, March 20, 2026, vs April 4, 2025; UAF and UAS, March 23, 2026, vs April 7, 2025.

#### **Applications**

A total of 13,795 applications have been started by prospective students for Fall 2026, up 26 percent (2,850) from Fall 2025. The number of initiated applications to UA Anchorage was down 11 percent (496), while UA Fairbanks increased 52 percent (3,386), and UA Southeast activity increased 5 percent (21) year-over-year.

About 71 percent of applications for Fall 2026 have resulted in admission to a program or course. Of the 9,835 students accepted so far, 6 percent (585) have elected to enroll, to-date. This represents a 50 percent (196 students) increase over this time last year.

#### **Course Registration**

With 19 weeks to go before the start of instruction, 5,399 students had registered for 58,331 Fall 2026 semester student credit hours (SCH). Year-over-year, this represents a 44 percent increase in headcount (1,659 additional students) and an almost 44 percent increase in SCH registration (17,774 SCH). Around 4 percent of students (197) are concurrently enrolled in more than one university for Fall 2026.

Compared to last year at this time, UAA headcount increased almost 50 percent (971 students), and SCH was around 46 percent higher (9,680 SCH). See page 2 for additional UAA detail by academic unit.

UAF headcount increased over 45 percent (732 students), with students registering in around 44 percent more (7,544) SCH year-over-year. See page 3 for additional UAF detail by academic unit.

At UAS, student headcount increased over 38 percent (94 students) from Fall 2025, and student credit hour registration grew around 24 percent (550 SCH). See page 4 for additional UAS detail by academic unit.

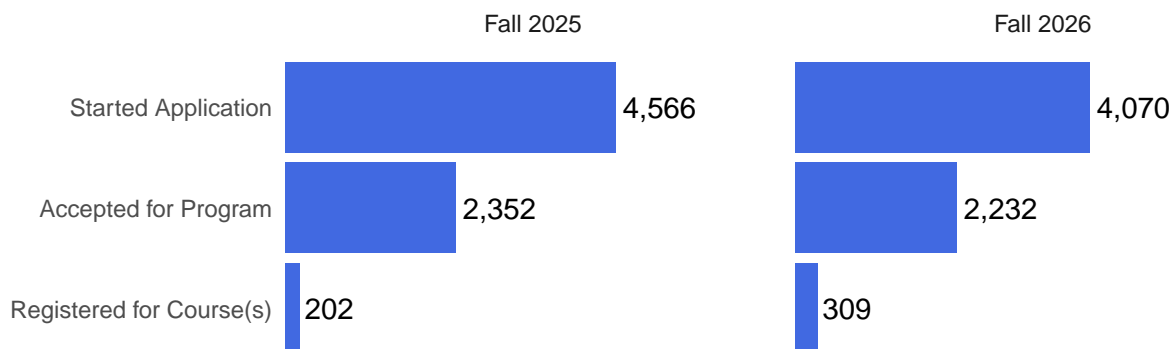

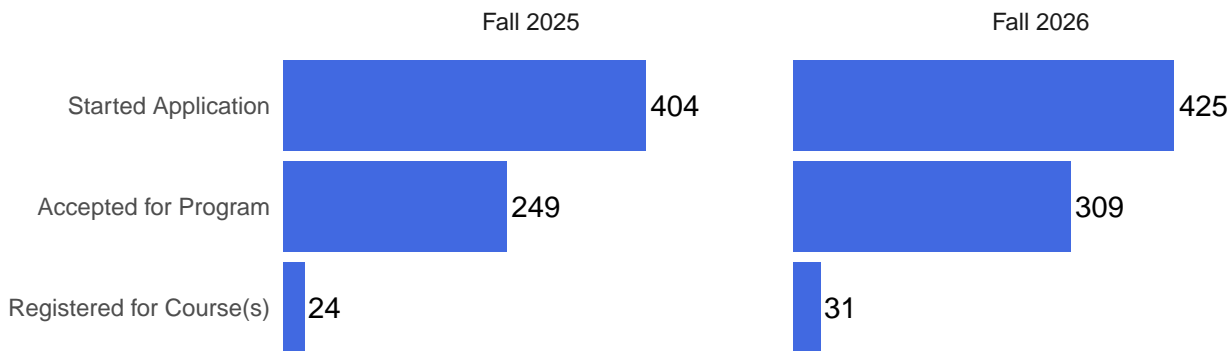

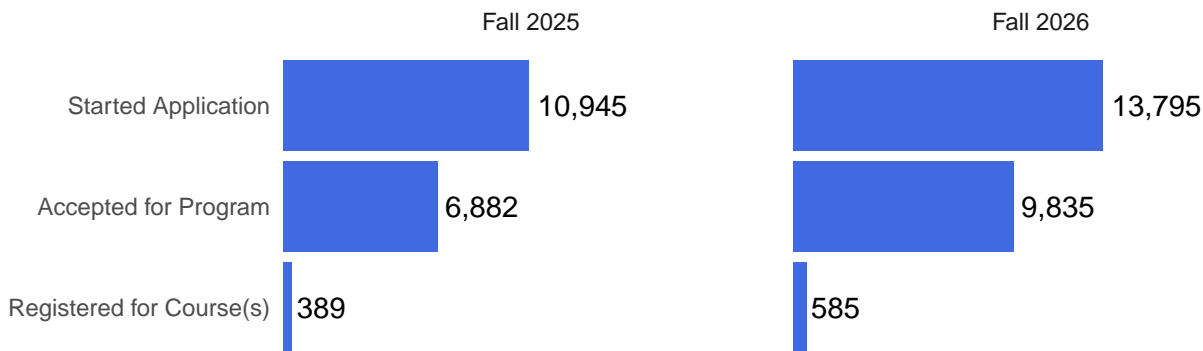
