

Preliminary Course Registration and Admission Activity, Fall 2026

4 Weeks Before Start of Instruction

July 27, 2026

The following compares student activity 4 weeks prior to the first day of instruction for Fall 2026 and Fall 2025 semesters. Information reported here is normalized to the first day of instruction for a given term to provide accurate trend comparisons and projections at the university and system levels. Trends presented here may differ from internal, university reports utilizing alternate date comparisons appropriate to institutional needs.

Fall 2026 semester instruction begins Monday, August 24 and Fall 2025 semester instruction began Monday, August 25. Trends are considered preliminary at this point, with normal business practice refinements also influencing early activity year-over-year. For example, each university opened Fall 2026 course registration fifteen days earlier than for Fall 2025: UAA, March 20, 2026, versus April 4, 2025; UAF and UAS, March 23, 2026, versus April 7, 2025.

Admissions

Prospective students have started a total of 17,137 applications for Fall 2026, up 16 percent (2,324) from Fall 2025. Applications initiated at UA Anchorage decreased 13 percent (902),¹ UA Fairbanks increased 42 percent (3,247), and UA Southeast increased 1 percent (8), year-over-year.

About 70 percent of applications for Fall 2026 have resulted in admission to a program or course. Of the 11,917 students accepted so far, almost 27 percent (3,200) have elected to enroll, to-date. This represents a 4 percent decrease (121 students) in new, enrolled program majors over this time last year.

Course Registration

With 4 weeks remaining before the start of instruction, 14,017 students have registered for 142,373 Fall 2026 semester student credit hours (SCH). Year-over-year, headcount and SCH are relatively unchanged (35 additional students and 1,294 additional SCH). Nearly 4 percent of students (537) are concurrently enrolled in more than one university for Fall 2026.

Compared to last year at this time, UAA headcount and SCH are relatively unchanged (51 fewer students and 733 fewer SCH). See page 2 for additional UAA detail by academic unit.

UAF headcount increased around 2 percent (131 students), with students registering in nearly 4 percent more (2,104) SCH year-over-year. See page 3 for additional UAF detail by academic unit.

At UAS, student headcount and SCH both decreased roughly 1 percent compared to this time last year (15 fewer students and 77 fewer SCH). See page 4 for additional UAS detail by academic unit.

¹In April 2026, UAA implemented a fraud-prevention software platform to identify potentially bogus applications from entering our data systems. This creates a difference in application numbers between Fall 2025 and Fall 2026. For Fall 2025, this software was not in use and there were bogus applications in the count. As those do not appear for Fall 2026, it creates a misleading impression of a gap between the years that is not as large as portrayed in this count.

Course Registration

Valid trends are reported by normalizing dates relative to the start of instruction for each Fall semester. Fall 2026 semester instruction begins Monday, August 24 and Fall 2025 semester instruction began Monday, August 25. Headcount is unduplicated at the reporting level, counting each student once and only once at each academic unit, academic organization and university that they enrolled at. Summing headcount over academic unit, academic organization and university will double count students and add up to more than the unduplicated system total, due to students utilizing courses from more than one location. Data is provided by UAA, UAF and UAS, extracted at 5pm on the report date from UA information systems.

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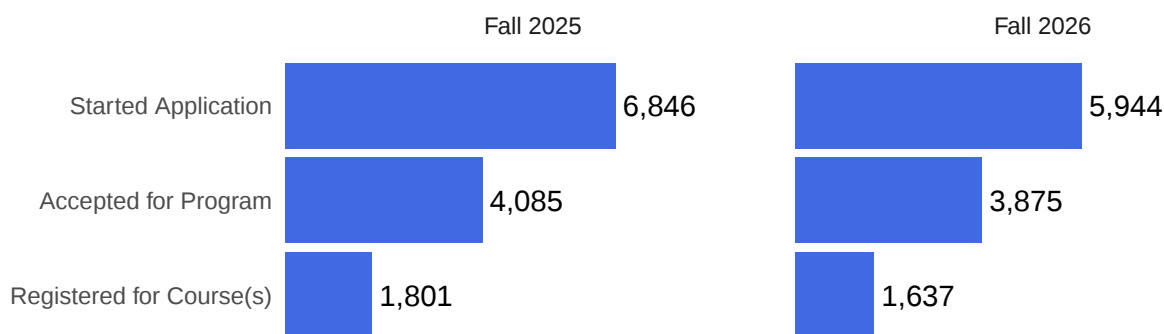

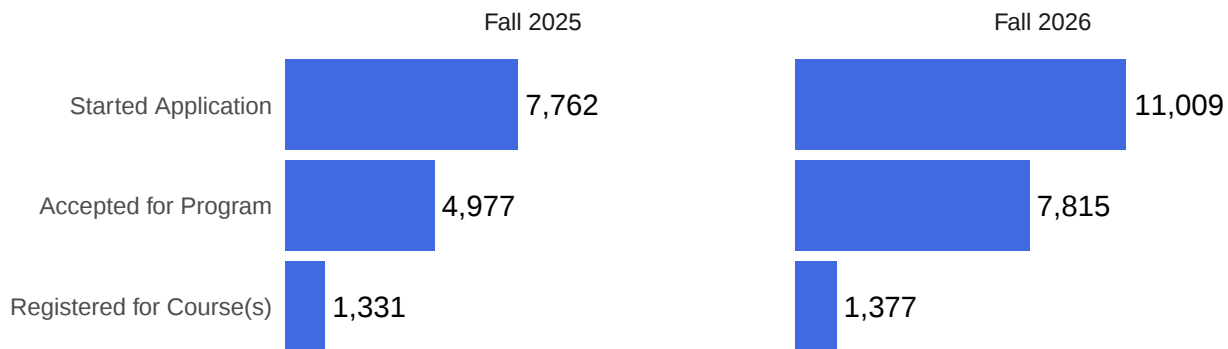

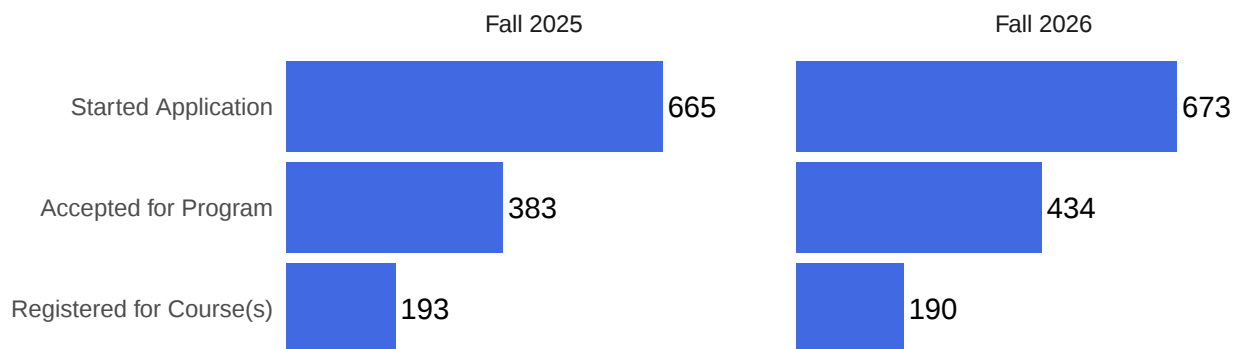

UAS Application Funnel



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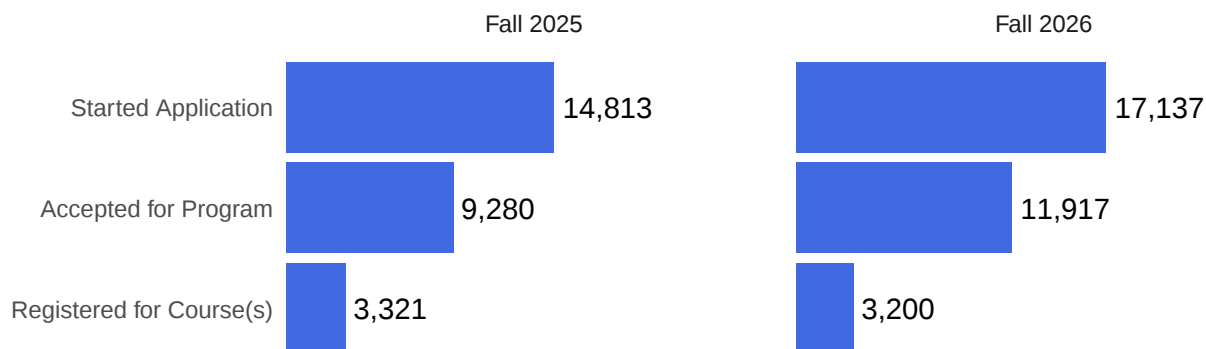

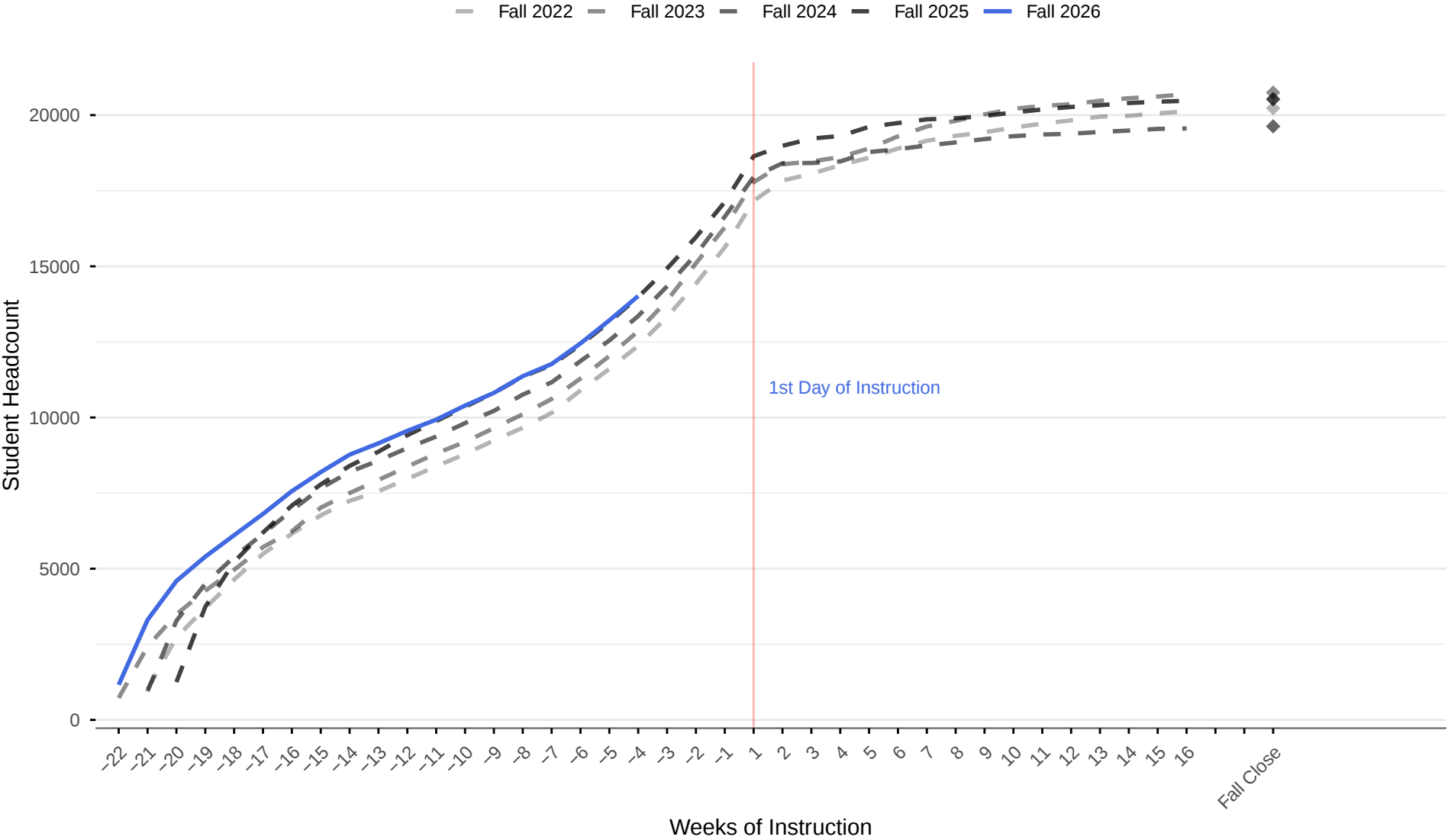
