

Preliminary Course Registration and Admission Activity, Fall 2026

Start of Instruction

August 24, 2026

The following compares student activity between the first day of instruction for Fall 2026 (August 24, 2026) and Fall 2025 (August 25, 2025). Trends are normalized relative to the first day of instruction.

Closing Outlook

If current trends hold, roughly 20,370 students are anticipated to enroll by the close of the Fall 2026 term, representing minimal change (a decrease of 156 students) from Fall 2025. Student credit hour (SCH) registration is similarly projected to hold steady, reaching roughly 185,150 SCH (403 fewer SCH) by the end of the semester. Historical and current system-level course registration trends for headcount and SCH are detailed on pages 12 and 13, respectively.

Course Registration

As of August 24, 2026, 18,496 students had registered for 180,762 Fall semester credit hours, system wide. This represents a minimal change in headcount (142 fewer students) and SCH (394 fewer credits) from the levels observed at this time last year.

At UAA, student headcount and student credit hours decreased over 1 percent, down 137 students and 1,187 SCH compared to last year. Kodiak College provided a key area of growth, increasing SCH registration by over 20 percent (478 SCH). See page 2 for additional UAA detail by academic unit.

UAF student headcount held steady (up 4 students) and student credit hour registration increased over 1 percent (767 SCH), year-over-year. One area of growth was the College of Liberal Arts, experiencing registration SCH growth of almost 5 percent (842 SCH) compared to this time last year, offsetting declines at other units for Fall 2026. UAS headcount and SCH remain relatively unchanged, with 4 fewer students and 26 additional SCH compared to this time last year. The Ketchikan Campus saw a nearly 28 percent increase in SCH registration (505 SCH), offsetting declines at other units. See page 4 for additional UAS detail by academic unit.

Over four percent of registered students (760) are taking classes concurrently at multiple universities within the system this semester.

Applications

About 17,899 prospective students started applications for the Fall 2026 term, compared to 15,732 applications initiated in Fall 2025. This is an increase of 14 percent (2,167 applications), year-over-year. Almost 70 percent of applications for Fall 2026 have resulted in admission to a program or course. Of the 12,426 students accepted so far, over 37 percent (4,656) have elected to enroll at this time. This represents a decrease of 2 percent (105) year-over-year.

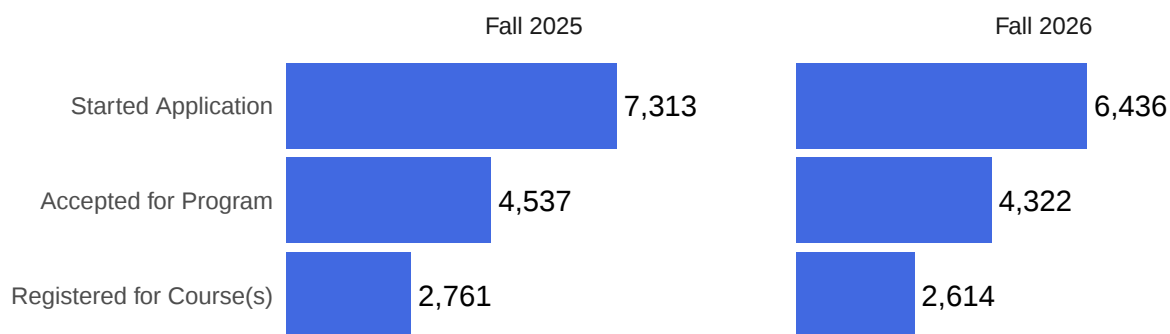

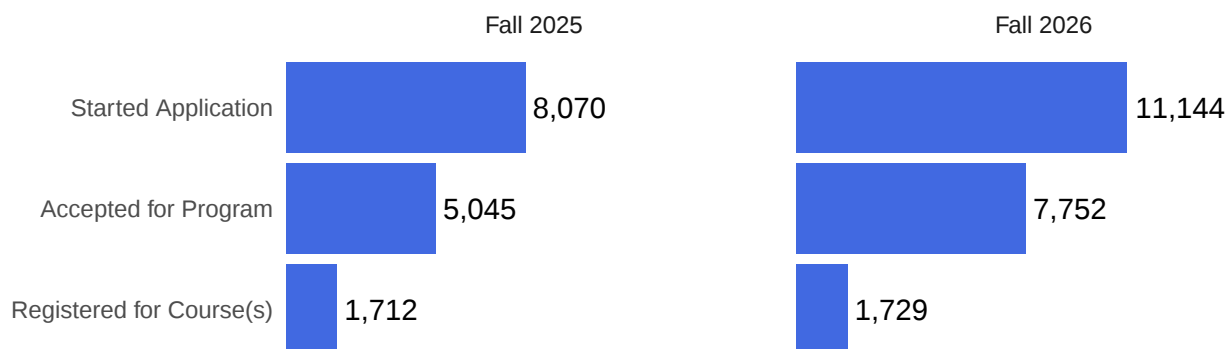

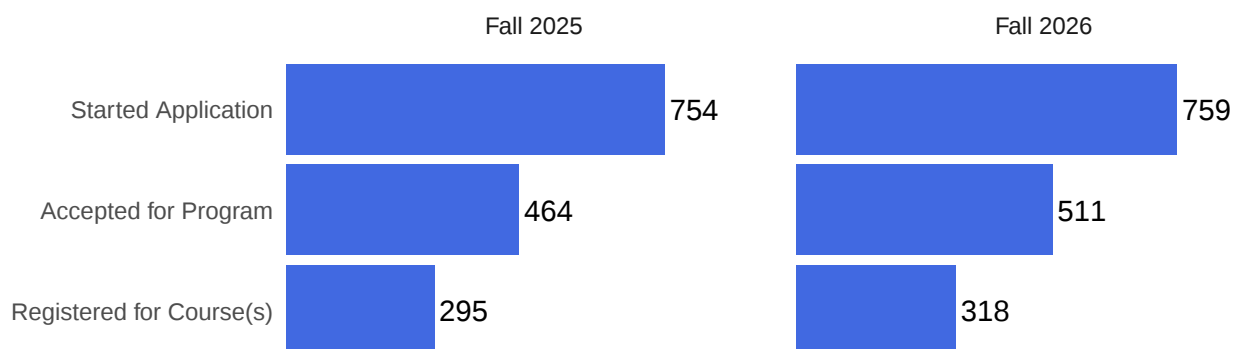

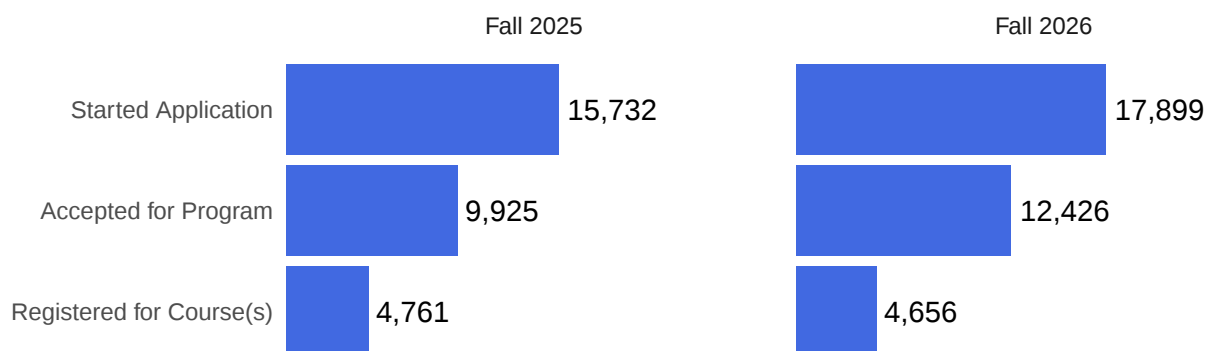

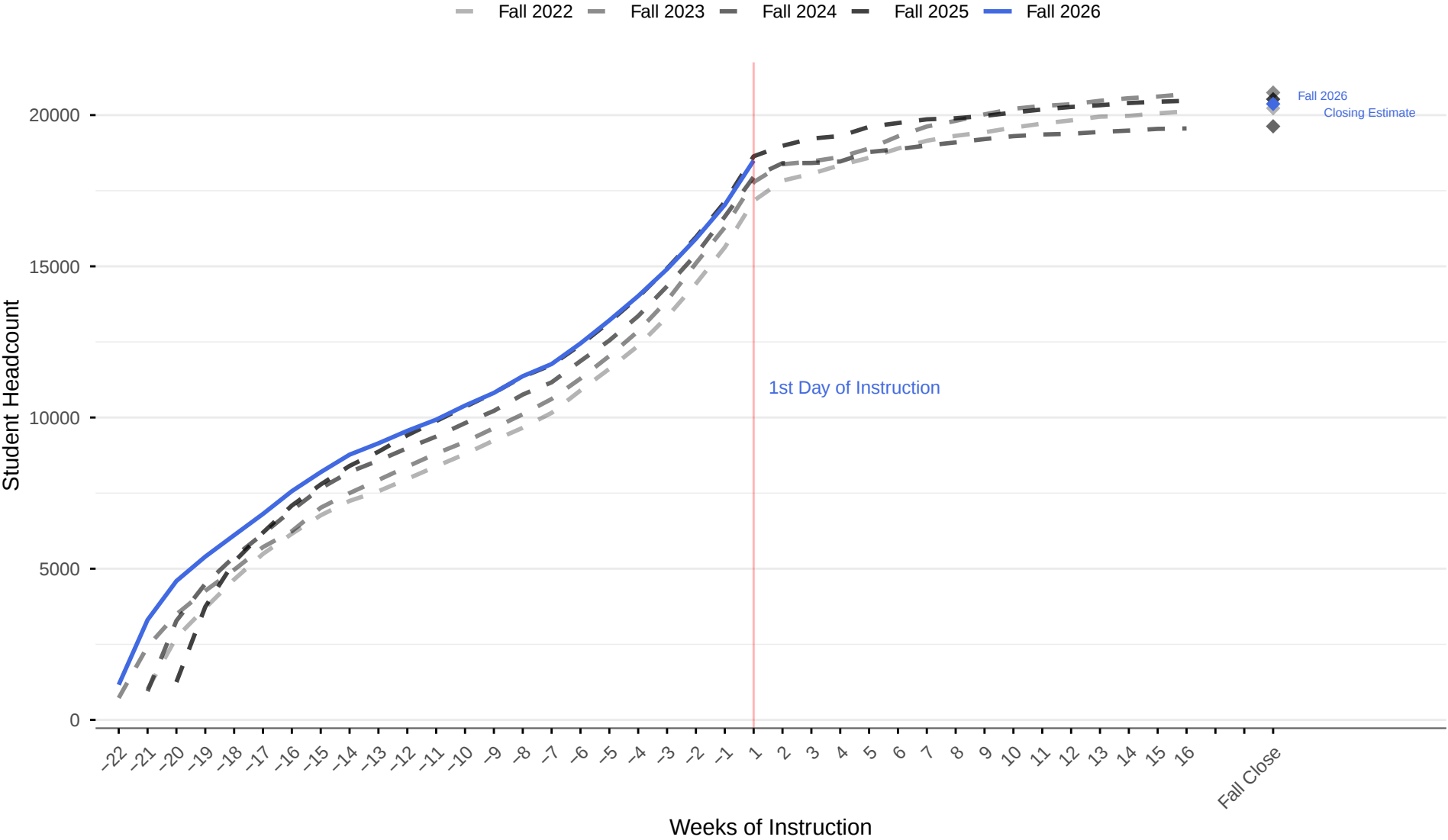
