

Preliminary Course Registration, Summer 2026

10 Weeks Before Start of Instruction

March 09, 2026

This report summarizes year-over-year Summer semester registration trends as of March 09, 2026. Comparisons are normalized relative to the first day of instruction¹ and Summer 2026 semester instruction begins Monday, May 18.

As of March 09, 2026, 2,194 students were registered in 13,286 student credit hours (SCH) system wide for Summer 2026 semester. Headcounts and SCH registration have increased around 10 percent (203 students) and 11 percent (1,328 SCH) from Summer 2025, year-over-year.

Around four percent of registered students (85 students) are taking classes concurrently at multiple universities within the system this semester.

UA Anchorage

UAA course registration headcount increased about 16 percent and SCH increased about 15 percent from Summer 2025 registration at this time last year. More than 1,177 students have registered for almost 6,794 SCH in Summer 2026 courses at UAA, to-date. This represents 164 more students and an increase of 897 SCH, year-over-year.

Eleven UAA academic units and campuses are offering courses in Summer 2026, with over half growing in SCH registration compared to last year at this time. The largest driver of the net increase in UAA student credit hour registration was a year-over-year growth of 384 SCH at the College of Arts and Sciences, equivalent to around 43 percent of the net UAA increase. UA Fairbanks

UAF course registration headcount increased almost 2 percent and SCH increased around 4 percent for Summer 2026 compared to last year. More than 916 students have registered for almost 5,473 SCH for Summer 2026 courses at UAF, to-date. This represents 15 more students and an increase of 231 SCH, year-over-year.

Thirteen UAF academic units and campuses are offering courses in Summer 2026, with over half growing in SCH registration compared to last year at this time. The College of Natural Science and Mathematics and the Community and Technical College were the largest drivers of net SCH growth at UAF, delivering an additional 119 and 309 SCH year-over-year, respectively. UA Southeast

UAS course registration headcount grew 16 percent and SCH increased around 25 percent for Summer 2026 compared to last year. More than 189 students have registered for almost 1,019 SCH for Summer 2026 courses at UAS, to-date. This represents 26 more students and an increase of 201 SCH, year-over-year.

Five UAS academic units and campuses are offering courses in Summer 2026, over half of which have grown in SCH registration compared to last year at this time. The largest driver of net SCH growth was the Ketchikan Campus, which increased 119 SCH year-over-year and was equivalent to almost 59 percent of net UAS SCH growth.
