Spring 2024 Course Registration, Revenue and Applications Fourth Week of Spring 2024 Instruction February 6, 2024

The following is a summary of spring semester enrollment activity as of Tuesday, February 6, 2024. Figures have been normalized relative to the first day of instruction for spring term. The date for administrative withdrawal due to non-fee payment has passed at each university; students will continue to enroll in short and late start classes through the end of the term.

To-date, spring 2024 course registration activity surpasses that observed for spring 2023. Estimates indicate 86 percent of all students who will enroll by the end of spring 2024 have already registered in 95 percent of student credit hours (SCH).

About 21,300 students are anticipated to enroll by the close of spring 2024, a projected increase of about 4.7 percent (950 students) over spring 2023. Likewise, student credit hour registration is anticipated to increase by about 6 percent (8,900 SCH) over last year, reaching 163,600 SCH by the end of term. Graphs displaying historical and current course registration patterns for headcount and SCH are provided on pages 6 and 7, respectively.

By the fourth week of spring 2024 instruction, 18,286 students were registered for 155,682 credit hours, system wide. This represents an increase of about 6 percent in headcount (988 students) and student credit hour registration (9,201 SCH), year-over-year. UAA student headcount increased 9.9 percent (940 additional students) and student credit hours are up 8.7 percent (7,068 SCH) compared to last year. UAF student headcount is 1.9 percent (124 students) higher and student credit hour registration is 4.3 percent (2,284 SCH) higher than this time last year. UAS headcount is 3.2 percent (59 students) higher and student credit hour registration 1.2 percent (151 SCH) lower than this time last year. Net tuition and fee revenue for spring 2024 totals \$56.7M currently, an increase of 6.5 percent (\$3.5M) over last year at this time. Undergraduate tuition revenue increased 6.8 percent (\$2.3M) and graduate tuition revenue increased 10.6 percent (\$0.5M) compared to last year. UAA revenue is up 7.3 percent (\$2.0M), UAF revenue is up about 6.9 percent (\$1.4M), and UAS revenue is relatively unchanged compared to this time last year. Across the UA system 5,211 applications have been initiated by prospective students for admission in spring 2024, up about 20 percent (845) from spring 2023. Increases in the number of applications initiated by prospective first-time freshman were observed at each university, compared to last year: applications started or completed for UAA grew by almost 17 percent (452), for UAF by about 23 percent (314), and for UAS by close to 22 percent (77). Applications initiated by an individual may be pending information or may be completed and ready for admission consideration. 
