## Summary: Fiscal Year Enrollment

Fiscal year enrollment considers activity in consecutive summer, fall, and spring terms. For example, FY23 represents summer 2022, fall 2022 and spring 2023 semesters. A student is counted if they enrolled in one or more semesters during the fiscal year.

The number of distinct students taking at least one for-credit or non-credit course decreased 22.5 percent (39,383 to 30,529) between FY19-FY23 and 1.8 percent (31,102 to 30,529) from FY22-FY23 (Table 1.24a). The total number of students taking at least one for-credit course in FY23 was 29,658, a 1.8 percent decrease from 30,213 in FY22. Of these, 57.6 percent (17,084 students) registered at UAA, 37.3 percent (11,067 students) at UAF, and the remaining 11.6 percent (3,453 students) at UAS (Table 1.24b). The total number of students taking at least one non-credit course decreased by 37.7 percent from FY19-FY23 (1,995 to 1,242 students). The trend reversed FY22-FY23 with the total number of students taking at least one non-credit course increasing by 8.3 percent from 1,147 to 1,242 students (Table 1.24c).

Total student credit hours attempted decreased 2.9 percent from 363,548 in FY22 to 353,100 in FY23 (Table 1.25).

Total student full-time equivalents (FTE) decreased by 27.8 percent from FY19-FY23 (16,721 to 12,075) and decreased by 2.9 percent from FY22-FY23 (12,440 to 12,075) (Table 1.26).

Dual enrollment is enrollment in a postsecondary course by a K-12 student, on a university campus or at their school. This includes enrollment where a student earns both secondary and postsecondary credit, and also includes enrollments for which no K-12 credit is earned.

In FY23, 2,836 students were dual enrolled, a 22.0 percent increase from FY22 (2,324 students) and a 16.0 percent increase from FY19 (2,444 students). High school students taking a class from UAA increased 28.0 percent, from 1,030 in FY22 to 1,318 in FY23. UAF dual enrollment students increased 22.2 percent from 1,198 students in FY22 to 1,464 students in FY23 and UAS dual enrollment increased 8.5 percent from 331 students to 359 (Table 1.13c) during the same period.

Dual enrollment students attempted a total of 24,556 student credit hours (SCH), representing 6.9 percent of total credits delivered system wide in FY23. Dual enrollment SCH increased by 15.0 percent from FY22 and 18.6 percent from FY19. Dual enrollment SCH at UAA increased by 17.8 percent from 12,152 in FY22 to 14,321 in FY23. UAF delivered 8,175 SCH to high school students in FY23 which is a 14 percent increase from FY22 (7,173 SCH). During the same period, dual enrollment SCH remained relatively unchanged at UAS (Table 1.20c).

Note: For non-credit courses with contact hours, 10 course contact hours are equivalent to one non-credit instructional productivity unit (NCU). For instance, if 300 students take a non-credit course with 5 contact hours, 150 NCUs would be generated. If a non-credit course provides continuing education units (CEUs), one CEU is generally equivalent to one NCU. Many non-credit courses have associated course contact hours, however 68% of FY23 non-credit courses had no set contact hours. For this reason, some academic organizations displayed in Table 1.24c with non-credit student headcount do not have associated NCU in the table above.
