In Fall 2022 7.6 percent of student credit hours (SCH) were taken by students enrolled in three or fewer credits, accounting for 28 percent of the total headcount (Table 1.13a). Students enrolled in 12 SCH or more accounted for 59.7 percent of UA's total SCH and represented 35.1 percent of the total student headcount. Students enrolled in 15 SCH or more accounted for 23.4 percent of UA's total SCH and 11.8 percent of UA's total student headcount.

Note: Due to rounding, university totals may not add exactly. A student may take credit hours at multiple AOs within a university or multiple universities within the system. Consequently, the credit hours attempted per student may shift to higher categories when moving from the AO level to the university level to the system level. The sum of credit hours per student for AOs or universities in a given category will not equal the credit hours per student at the same level for the university or system.

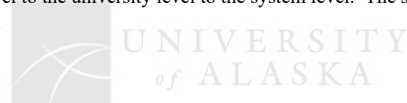
