

## Summary: Employment

As of October 2022, the UA system had 6,225 regular or temporary employees. This is a decrease of 12.9 percent from 2018 employment numbers (Table 3.02). Of those employed by the UA system, 3,465 are fulltime regular staff, and 2,291 are part time temporary staff and the remaining 469 are split between the remaining categories (Table 3.02).

Since fall 2018, regular faculty staff headcount has decreased by 9.2 percent, regular professional staff headcount has increased by 8.6 percent, and the headcount of regular technical staff fell by 20.4 percent (Table 3.04). The total regular employee headcount changes for all categories decreased by 3.5 percent in 5 years (Table 3.04).

Since fall 2018 temporary employee headcount has decreased by 23.5 percent (Table 3.04). The largest decrease in this group was the grad assistant and student temp headcount with a decrease of 34.8 percent (Table 3.04). The second largest decrease was temporary technical employees which decreased by 28.4 percent (Table 3.04). These were offset by a 55.1 percent increase in temporary professional headcount, and a 26.2 percent in crafts/trades/maintenance headcount (Table 3.04).

From fall 2018 to 2022 the number of employees who self-identified as Black decreased by 23.5 percent, white decreased by 15.7 percent, and Alaskan Native or American Indian decreased by 13.2 percent (Table 3.06c). The 1-year change for these three groups have seen an increase for Black headcount by 1.3 percent, white decreased by 1.9, and Alaskan Native or American Indian increased by 3.5 percent. The biggest 1-year increase was Asians with a headcount increase of 10.8 percent (Table 3.06c).

From 2018 to 2022 female employment has decreased by 13.1 percent and male employment has decreased by 12.8 percent (Table 3.06a). The 1-year change for female employment decreased by 1.8 percent and male employment increased by 2.8 (Table 3.06a).

Full-time and part-time faculty headcount was 1,875 which is a decrease system wide by 14.1 percent from 2018 (Table 3.07). Of all faculty during 2022, the headcount of regular full-time faculty was 1058, and temporary part-time faculty had a headcount of 728 (Table 3.07). Part-time regular faculty headcount was 85, and fulltime temporary faculty have a headcount of 4. Faculty headcount decreased at UA Anchorage by 23.1 percent, decreased at UA Fairbanks by 5.1 percent, and increased at UA Southeast increased by 2.3 (Table 3.07).

In fall 2022, 46.3 percent of all faculty were tenured, 15.3 percent were eligible but not tenured, and the remaining 38.4 percent are not eligible for tenure (Table 3.10a). UA Anchorage has 51.8 percent tenured professors, UA Fairbanks has 41.6 percent tenured professors, and UA Southeast has 43.8 percent tenured professors (Table 3.10a).

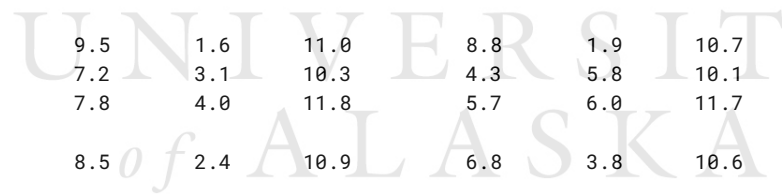
