#### Summary: Financial Aid and Costs for All Students

In Aid Year (AY) 2024-25, 11,147 degree-seeking students and 1,039 non-degree-seeking students received at least one type of financial aid system wide (Table 4). This includes grants, scholarships, loans, and some tuition waivers. Institutional tuition discounts such as the Western Undergraduate Exchange and the Come Home Alaska discount, as well as tuition and fee waivers associated with university employment, are not categorized as financial aid.

Over the last five years, total financial aid distributions to UA students increased 10.8 percent (\$11.2 million), from \$105.0 million in AY2020-21 to \$116.3 million in AY2024-25. In the last year, financial aid distributions increased 17.2 percent (\$17.0 million) from \$99.3 million in AY2023-24 to \$116.3 million in AY2024-25. Grant awards increased by 32.3 percent (\$7.3 million) in the last year, and scholarships awarded increased 26.6 percent (\$11.8 million). Tuition and fee waivers increased 30.5 percent (\$269.2 thousand) in the last year. Federal student financial aid paid to students increased by 8.9 percent (\$4.1 million) in the last year. Financial aid paid to students from private sources remained relatively in line with the previous aid year (Table 2).

To receive financial aid, a student must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form. Alaska high school seniors complete the FAFSA at the lowest rate in the country, with only 31.6 percent of 2024-25 seniors submitting a complete application by July 2025<sup>1</sup>. Alaska is roughly 7 percentage points behind the 2<sup>nd</sup> lowest state, Utah, and the 33.0 percentage points behind Tennessee, the state with the highest FAFSA completion rate.

Need-based financial aid award amounts have increased by 51.0 percent (\$11.5 million) since AY2020-21. In the last year, need-based financial aid award amounts increased by 48.6 percent (\$11.1 million). At UAA, need-based financial aid awards increased by 35 percent (\$4.4 million), at UAF 1,008.2 percent (\$390.6 thousand), at UAS 7.7 percent (\$130.6 thousand, Table 6).


