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Summary: Retention Rates

The retention rate measures the proportion of first-time, full-time students enrolled in the Fall who return the following Fall. University-level retention tracks students who re-enroll for credit at the same university the following Fall, while UA System-level retention tracks those who re-enroll at any university within the system.

Over the last five years, the retention rate for freshmen seeking any degree increased from 65.8 percent to 69.3 percent (Table 1). During this period, the retention rate for Indigenous students seeking any degree increased from 52.6 percent to 55.8 percent (Table 2). According to recent nationwide data, 62.3 percent of students at four-year, public, open-enrollment institutions who started in Fall 2022 returned in Fall 2023 (NCES 2024¹). In comparison, the UA System's retention rate for the same period was 66.8 percent overall (Table 1), and the overall Indigenous retention rate was 55.4 percent (Table 2).

In four-year programs, 75.2 percent of bachelor-seeking freshmen were retained from Fall 2024 to Fall 2025, a 1.6 percentage point increase from the previous year, reaching a ten-year high (Table 3). For Indigenous students at the bachelor's degree-seeking level, the retention rate from Fall 2024 to Fall 2025 was 58.7 percent, an 2.8 percentage point increase from the previous year (Table 4).

In two-year programs, 57.6 percent of associate degree-seeking freshmen were retained from Fall 2024 to Fall 2025, 1.8 percentage points lower than the previous year's rate (Table 5). Retention rates for associate degree-seekers have decreased at all universities and at the system level. The retention rate for Indigenous associate degree-seeking freshmen increased 4.7 percentage points from 48.7 percent to 53.4 percent (Table 6).

The retention rate for students seeking certificates or occupational endorsements increased by 0.7 percentage points to 34.4 percent between Fall 2024 and Fall 2025 (Table 7). During this period, Indigenous freshmen seeking certificates or occupational endorsements had a retention rate of 36.8 percent, a 5.8 percentage point increase from the previous year (Table 8).

The retention rate for Pell Grant recipients seeking any undergraduate degree reached 63.1 percent at the UA System level, a ten-year high. Pell Grant recipients seeking a bachelor's degree had a retention rate of 69.6 percent, also a ten-year high (Table 9). The retention rate for Indigenous Pell recipients seeking any undergraduate degree remained stable at 46.9 percent in the last year. Indigenous Pell recipients seeking a bachelor's degree had a retention rate increase of 1.7 percentage points over the past year, bringing the current rate to 52.4 percent (Table 10).
