## **Master's of Electrical Engineering Deletion**

The Master's of Electrical Engineering (MEE) is a non-thesis master's program. Earlier, several UAF non-thesis engineering programs were established that had distinctive degree names (for example, the MCE or Master's of Civil Engineering). However, most College of Engineering and Mines M.S. degrees simply have thesis and non-thesis options within the single M.S. degree, and since the course requirements are very similar, this is a simpler approach that CEM intends to implement for all of its master's programs. This will be more convenient for students wishing to switch between thesis and non-thesis options after initial enrollment, as well.
