

Aligns with University or campus mission, goals, core themes, and objectives (list): The MA in Applied Anthropology aligns with <i>UAA 2025</i> by highlighting the value of cultural diversity, community partnerships, and thoughtful engagement/change. The program name change more accurately reflects the program as designed and approved in 1999. The MA in Anthropology at UAA was initiated as an applied program, distinguishing it from UAF's more academic orientation. It is one of a handful of programs in the US that focuses on applied anthropology, and that distinction should be represented in the degree name to attract students interested in an applied anthropology degree. The program previously had two different tracks, general and applied. At the time the general track was removed, more than 75% of all degrees awarded since the program's inception had been in the applied track.
