Attached are the Program Action Request (PAR) forms seeking Board of Regents action to discontinue the Applied Environmental Science and Technology Master and the Applied Environmental Science and Technology Master of Science. Also attached is the UAA letter to the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) dated August 25, 2015 informing the NWCCU of the suspension of admissions to the program.

Admissions to the two graduate degrees were suspended in August 2015 with planned deletion as a result of Program Prioritization due to declining enrollment and insufficient faculty resources. Consistent with UAA's suspension guidelines, a teach out has been completed and no students remain in the programs. There are no resources or faculty tied to the programs. There are no other impacts on programs or stakeholders.

Dear Dr. Elman,

This letter is to notify the Commission of the suspension of admissions into 26 degrees and certificates at the University of Alaska Anchorage. These suspensions resulted from a multi-year process of Program Prioritization, as well as other transactions which were underway even as prioritization played out.

The faculty Program Prioritization Academic Task Force reviewed all academic programs for alignment with UAA's mission, strategic plan, and the needs of UAA's students and the state. With the release of the Program Prioritization findings in February 2015, faculty were charged with providing recommendations for the programs placed in categories four (transform) or five (deletion/further review). Those recommendations were submitted to the deans of each college, the deans reviewed those recommendations, and then forwarded proposed actions to the provost in May. The provost reported final decisions to the UAA community on June 18, 2015.

Consistent with UAA's suspension guidelines, the colleges have submitted a plan for each suspended program to accommodate current majors, as well as a plan to communicate with students and other stakeholders. Institutional services and resources will continue to be available to students as they complete these programs. The programs planned for deletion will be submitted through the appropriate approval processes after existing students have been accommodated according to their catalog year. The attached summaries illustrate the considerations that went into the decisions to suspend these programs.

Program suspensions are approved by the appropriate dean, the Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, and the Chancellor. This notification will be submitted to the UA System Vice President for Academic Affairs and Research, so he can notify the Board of Regents.

We ask that the Commission update its record of UAA's programs to reflect these changes. If you have questions, please do not hesitate to contact us.
