Discontinuation of the Nutrition Bachelor of Science

Attached is the Program Action Request (PAR) form seeking Board of Regents action to discontinue the Nutrition Bachelor of Science. Also attached is the UAA letter to the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) dated August 14, 2014 informing the NWCCU of the continued suspension of admissions to the program.

Admissions to the program were initially suspended and a teach out put into place in July 2011, due to insufficient capacity and pending further consideration. It was decided to focus resources on the accredited Dietetics Bachelor of Science and on the development of the new Dietetics and Nutrition Master of Science. The Dietetics and Nutrition Master of Science was approved in 2017 and was developed due to changing entry-level qualifications for Registered Dietician Nutritionists. These two remaining programs align with state needs and changing professional requirements to work in the field.

Consistent with UAA's suspension guidelines, a teach out of all students in the Nutrition Bachelor of Science has been completed and no students remain in the programs. There are no resources or faculty tied to the program. There are no other impacts on programs or stakeholders.
