Department: Department of Indigenous, Community and Tribal Programs

The Construction Trades Technology Program (CTT) is requesting the deletion of the Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree program, which has been in suspension since 2014. The AAS degree was originally suspended due to little to no enrollment, graduates and a lack of industry support, as the AAS is not an industry recognized credential.

There are currently no active students within the AAS, and the discontinuation will not result in the climination or reassignment of any positions within the CTT Program. Additionally, there will be no budgetary impact and no other programs or areas will be affected by the discontinuation of the program.

No new applications have been accepted since October 1, 2014, for a two-year period the Construction Trades Technology Program will accommodate, through other arrangements, any student who contact the program expressing a desire to complete their degree.
