Discontinuation of the Paralegal Studies Undergraduate Certificate

Attached is the Program Action Request (PAR) form seeking Board of Regents Action to discontinue the Paralegal Studies Undergraduate Certificate. Also attached is the UAA letter to the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) dated August 21, 2014 informing the NWCCU of the suspension of admissions to the program.

Admissions to the Undergraduate Certificate were suspended in 2012 with planned deletion when it was replaced by an Associate of Applied Science and a Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in response to community needs and changing industry regulations. It was further identified for deletion as a result of Program Prioritization. Consistent with UAA's suspension guidelines, a teach out has been completed and no students remain in the program. The resources and faculty which were tied to the program now support the revised curriculum. There are no other impacts on programs or stakeholders.
