The University of Alaska is committed to preparing today's students for tomorrow, recognizing that tomorrow's careers require advanced skills, greater knowledge, and more flexibility than ever before. Specific to the health industry, the University offers career and technical training as well as advanced degrees. This inventory provides the locations of programs and degrees or certificates offered in FY15, which includes three terms: summer 2014, fall 2014, and spring 2015.

The University of Alaska is unique in its offerings of education and training programs to assist in building a skilled workforce for the health industry:

- Core programs include vocational and technical training and advanced degrees directly related to the health industry.
 - 15 Occupational Endorsements, 13 Certificates, 23 Associate Degrees, 14 Bachelor's Degrees, 2
 Licensures, 1 Post Baccalaureate Certificate, 9 Graduate Certificates, 5 Master's Degrees, and 2
 Doctorates
 - o 4,778 degrees were awarded to graduates in the core programs between 2010 and 2014.
- Support programs include the broader vocational and technical training and advanced degrees in such fields as education, office technology, biology, rural development, and so on.

Workforce Training

The University of Alaska (UA) offers various courses to support the continuing education and professional development needs of Alaska's health workforce. Due to the volume of courses offered across the state, they are not all listed in this inventory. Additional information on these course can be found through the following UA departments and programs.



The Center for Human Development (CHD) is a University Center for Excellence in Developmental Disabilities in Education, Research, and Service (UCEDDs) authorized by the Developmental Disabilities Assistance and Bill of Rights Act of 2000. There are 67 UCEDDs, at least one in every state and territory, that form an Association of UCEDD's (AUCD.org). Since CHD is the only UCEDD in Alaska, we serve the entire state. The UAA Center for Human Development has 4 major functions; interdisciplinary education, community training and technical assistance, research, and information dissemination. These activities are designed to increase the independence, productivity, and community integration and inclusion for individuals with disabilities. The Alaska Training Cooperative (TTC) promotes career development opportunities for direct service workers, supervisors, and professionals in the field engaged with Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority beneficiaries, by ensuring that technical assistance and training is accessible and coordinated. In addition, the TTC is dedicated to collaborating with Alaskan communities to train rural behavioral health care providers by blending evidence-based practices with traditional wisdom. http://trusttrainingcoop.org/

The Alaska AHEC Program supports, coordinates, and disseminates information about continuing education (CE/CME) opportunities targeting health care professionals working in rural areas or with underserved populations. The goal of this program is to increase workforce retention by improving access to training. In order to closely monitor the CE/CME needs of providers in Alaska, the AHEC conducts periodic needs assessments in partnership with statewide health profession associations.
