1) Reports:

Course Schedule & Catalog—no report

Registration & Add/Drop—Mtg 8/14 & 15 in Fbx; have not met since Brigitte left for vacation. For the meeting in Fairbanks, team members should look at processes on the web—especially those that might need testing during the 8-14 & 15 meetings.

Unofficial Transcripts—Pilot begins 7/31; the team has been 'cooking'! JJ has kept up with all project requests and will discuss the "Help" issues at the Acad Hist mtg on 7-25. Ann reiterated the schedule for RATTI to be pointed to the production database (7-31). Once RATTI is pointed, some work still must occur—the look of some of the web forms for example. The 'pilot' will run from throughout August with a cutover to the UMGA-1 server on August 28. The suggestion to use current student staff to go out and retrieve grades and unofficial transcripts was made. UAF does plan to do this. Some staff with official records in Banner should also try and access through the web interface.

- 2) Requests: JJ brought up SFR2ACT. Discussion ensued surrounding the request to modify as requested by Peter Miller—estimated by software engineers as 12 hours. It was agreed that this job would be placed in the SIFA queue (once Saichi resends). AnnT mentioned that perhaps the form should be further modified so that when it is printed individually, it can be folded with the address showing through the window in a window envelope. This might be beneficial to UAS—the MAU currently mailing grades. Lori mentioned this practice will cease at the end of Summer. It was mentioned by more than one person that using SFR2ACT could be a viable way (once the modifications are done) to send out grade reports...
- 3) Known system down time (Published Document are there Questions)—network outages (those affecting Butrovich and other users) have been sent out by Mike Gardner to the BSIS and BFA.
- 4) JJ—JJ reiterated there are items in test that need to be looked at. She also reported back on the Honor's issue brought up by Lori from the last BST audio. In essence the issue can be approached using an approach similar to SHR2AST (which she is currently fixing). She (JJ) does not think it will be difficult. Lori mentioned that discussion on UAS have shifted to perhaps assessing the viability of the possibility of tracking ANY student taking a distance course, and having that course calculated into the GPA. Responses offered included that if the student were first identified—then you could calculate the distance course into the GPA using population election. The question was raised that if you were going to calculate for Honor's—shouldn't we also calc for probation?

'User ID' should be renamed to? Since the login page will ultimately be used by students, staff and faculty Carolyn suggested we use:

As the web components for staff and faculty are added, we can either drop the ‘student’ altogether:
