Agenda:

Determine which students to bring into PROD DegreeWorks. Want to do this on LRGP to get an idea of sizing needs.

- . Current rules bring in only students with a degree program of the selected undergraduate level with a catalog term of 200603 or greater and with a sgastdn term of 200603 or greater.
- . Current students (no graduate students based on sgastdn) enrolled within the system in 200603 and forward; active in a program at that institution; (SOC students brought over by id through Transit); this includes non-degree seeking attending within the system; new admits with transfer credits for term of admit and with term of admit greater than the start term (currently 200603)

Status reports

- . UAA
 - . Continuing testing – bringing more advisors on line within next two weeks
- . UAF
 - . Updating block rules for courses offered both letter graded and pass/fail, renumbered courses and courses with variable credits; mass testing with limited number of advisors in progress
- . UAS
 - . Slowed down due to registration, working on bachelor blocks, web mock up not arriving at destination, working through minors attaching correctly
- . Mark
 - . Prep for training – planning trip for Sept 30 through October 3 – October 3rd for UAF specific training – Others stay to observe training done for UAF (Mark leaving about 2:20 that day due to flight) – UAA will go home on Thursday, UAS stay? UAF training attendees for Friday need to be determined
 - . Backward scribing for UAA – lots of scribing hours left in the contract – UAA has 173 hours left, DW can give an estimate of the time to scribe the backward scribing; UAA is looking to go with current catalog (06-07) and move forward to newer catalog before scribing the backward catalogs; UAA with advisors and graduation going live in October and with students in April; want enough catalogs for students to be meaningful; (UAS has 87 hours of scribing; UAF has 423 hours left)
