New task requests

- . SFRSCHD -

We have had a request from staff in a couple of academic departments that they would love to be able to pull the SFRSCHD Student Schedule by CRN instead of (in addition to) SSN. There are not people available or trained to do Pop selects for them. When class times, locations, etc., change after students are enrolled, or added sections are being planned, this would greatly help the departments to look at the schedules for the enrolled students by course, and choose alternatives that would make the least impact on students, and greatly reduce the time it takes to work out options.

We suggest a new parameter "CRN", optional, multiples allowed, that would print SFRSCHD for all students enrolled or waitlisted. A second parameter may be needed to specify enrolled (R) and/or waitlisted (L), same as #12 Reg status on class list.

Would other campuses also find this useful? Thank you.

Banner will not consider the following two courses as duplicates, because the schedule code is different.

ENG 2113	English Comp	schedule code L (lecture)
ENG 2113	English Comp	schedule code WWW (web course).

When we noticed that a student had enrolled in two CRNs of this course, we thought that somehow the duplicate course Fatal check has just stopped working. It took a couple of hours to work this through and figure out what was happening.

Theoretically, then, each department could use different schedule codes for the seminar courses, i.e, S1,S2,S3. Of course, this screws everything up if you're using schedule codes for something else.

We have the same problem with seminars, practicums, and institutes, and wind up with lots of confusion over putting in override codes. So, I'm going to check out the possibility of using this feature defect whatever.

Mail message from Ron Illingworth:

Ron & Bernice:

Per the attached, and as a result of my discussions with both of you yesterday, I see that the voice registration system will be eliminated in the near future. I'm not sure of the implementation date. While that is probably not too bothersome for us in CRA since most of our off-site registrations happen via phone calls and faxes directly to rural campuses and rural education centers, the elimination of the ability to call in and receive your grades is more significant since most of our rural students have no other alternative to receive their grades.

>From talking with Mike Sfraga, I understand that the various MAU registration teams have been tasked with identifying transition processes. At UAF, I believe that Coleen Abrams chairs the Registration Work team charged with developing the transition plan. There are several issues which we must be aware of as this discussion progresses and transition solutions are identified.

- 1) What will the long-term replacement for the VR system be?
- 2) How long will a short-term transition solution be in effect?
- 3) Who will pay for the short-term and long-term solutions?
- 4) Will the solution provide for equal access for rural students as well as for urban students with more universal internet access?
- 5) How will the proposed solutions accommodate the requirements for distribution of final grades, mid-term grades, freshman progress reports, etc.

Possible solutions that I have heard mentioned include the following:

- 1) Internet posting of grades through UA Online
- 2) Establishment of an 800 number or numbers for students to use to obtain their grades
- 3) Mailout of grades as was done in the past

In a larger sense, this issue ties in with a need for a broad-based student support function which would provide services to students who/when (they) are not located on a regional campus where they have access to site-based student support functions.

As the discussion progresses, I hope that the discussion will address not just the issue of registration and grades, but the larger issue of how we can respond to the requirement to provide student service support to our students. At a recent conference held in Anchorage (Alaska College Reading and Learning Association) the composition faculty were unanimous in their recognition of the need for and their support for the development of an on-line writing lab which would be available for all UofA students. These seem to be initiatives which can and should be addressed simultaneously.

Thank you for your assistance in this.
