I tested the SFR2LST alpha sort in LrgP. It does print in the same order as SFASLST, to facilitate error-free grading. However, I noticed it does not sort in alpha order the first time it is printed; only the second time it is printed. In order to do testing, i had to change some last names in LrgP, then I ran a class list. The names were printed in the order that the previous last names would have been sorted. It was not until I ran a second roster that LrgP re-arranged the new names into the proper order. This was unexpected. In Prod, new names are sorted correctly in the first run following a change (I tested).

One drawback that has stopped discussion on this issue in the past is the idea that turning prerequisite checking on would slow the system so much that registration would become very difficult. Is this still the case?

All the top people here (Director, Academic Affairs, Faculty) very much want prerequisite checking on, as do academic counselors. Although it would be heck in registration for a semester or two and would involve a lot of work for curriculum people, it wouldn't be any worse than any of the other transitions that we've gone through and it would benefit students. Ultimately, we undermine everyone's efforts if we tell students they "must" do something and then allow them to avoid doing it.

If the system slow down issue is behind us, I say let's bring this up with the Provosts.

- * Sandy is hearing more about faculty and administration having pre-requisite checking turned on
- * Transfer student may not get in because courses were not transferred in with the required courses
- * UAS does not have pre-requisites on SCAPREQ and SSAPREQ
- * Faculty Senates may be looking at this issue now. Faculty at UAA is working on this now.
- * Turning it on may put too large a load on the Enrollment Services/Registrar's offices

Student was on the web and audited a course. (AM part of term)

The course – CIOS A130A 030 crn 31565 – does not show as VR/WEB Avail on SSASECT

I tried Tom in the course: registered him manually and went to the web
and no problem audit can be done
drop can be done – at 100%

While SSASECT is not tagged, SFARSTS was

Thought both forms were required for the registration activity to work
Apparently not

AARGH – not good

So, I turned off the web reg for AM (both DW and RW) then RW was turned back on.

Now – I receive a letter from a faculty member wanting to know WHY someone registered for a course that 20% finished.

It is an AM part of term, SSASECT is not checked for web – and yet the student registered. Tried the process on Tom a few minutes ago and indeed the course was registered.

We need to re-think what we're doing or how we're doing it. Somewhere something has been changed.
