Agenda Items:

Special Guest Speakers- Statewide Programmers!

Went through task schedule related to kick off of spring registration. Programmers will be in late on Sunday to monitor opening of registration. Things seem good. Reminder that there is a freeze from 11/7- 11/20 on all new projects, updates, etc in PROD.

Deceased Student Procedures- Reviewed deceased student procedures to reach consensus on process between MAUs. Lora will send out updated procedures from discussion today for final approval before forwarding to admissions work team.

Julie from Financial Aid dialed in to address questions about inactivating programs and impact on financial aid, as well as need to notify them.

Waitlisting- Lora shared results from her testing. SFRBWLP seems to hiccup at some point and stops purging DD students from waitlist. Can run out of sleep/awake mode to purge, but this is not ideal.

Also noted that if an instructor gives a capacity override it will move ahead of person on waitlist and allow immediate registration. This becomes problematic if individual has received notification that they may register and then a new student receives capacity override and registers, the open seat the first student was notified about no longer is available and they cannot register and they lose their spot on the waitlist.

Pin vs. Password- suggestion was made to change "pin" in UAOnline to "password" since it does not have to be a number and "pin" is confusing. Decision to wait until after changes occur with EDIR.

Priority Registration for Stay on Track- Discussed giving priority registration to those students who sign pledges to "stay on track". Concerns raised that students may sign pledge just to get priority registration. Also concerns about "priority registration" becoming meaningless if given to every group and that already there are multiple requests to allow a specific group priority. Discussed that tuition waivers should be the incentive and not tied to registration at this point.

Jane- David moved some modification to class search functionality to LRGP that will be moved into PROD tomorrow if you want to check it out.

Class Search and IPADs- Jennifer shared that many of their students are using IPADs for registration activity and that the "look up class" feature does not work well. Cannot search by subject, students must know CRN. They also get message "dummy" as part of search results ☺ Jane stated this is on the list to be worked on, just not sure when.
