1. TR 118 (SFR2PRQ): SFAREGS approvals.
Russ is looking into it. Will respond by email.

2. Waitlisting – discuss spring 2015.

UAA will turn off notifications on 1/12/15 at 8am.

MatSu, KPC will do the same.

Alyona will follow up with an email with UAA campuses regarding a uniform approach.

3. SSO – discuss what to expect and how to best guide students.

- The biggest struggle will be to have to claim the PW. Need message to walk people through the process for the first time.
- UAS has been having SSO issues all week. OIT is working on it. Seems to be related to Active directory.
- There's no default PW.
- It is not clear whether students and employees who are using the password for email and blackboard are able to just use the same password to log into UAOnline. That is the idea, but evidence shows it's not working this way. Many faculty opted out of using the new grading option because of having to claim the password in ELMO. They were receiving a message "Authentication failed".
- It will need to be clarified if all passwords are synced.
- The use name is created at 5am during pin reset process run. GOATPAC will trigger it with PIN reset, if you need it earlier than 5 am.
- One does not have to be a student or employee to have a user name.
- Currently what happens is if somebody is attempting to log into UAOnline with a password for the first time, they are redirected to the security questions page where they are asked to enter PIN. This is not right, it needs to be changed.
- Examples have been sent to programmers to test and check.
- Andrew is looking into confidentiality indicator fix.

Andrew is making the punch list to be addressed before the SSO is live in early February. Please direct all questions and concerns regarding SSO to the entire call team.
