1. TR 295 - Mass Drop of Enrolled Students for not meeting Prerequisites (see TR and Prereq Scenarios attached)

Patty put together the TR – can be campus specific. Goal is to avoid frustration due to enrollment in classes without meeting prereqs.

UAF – would be valuable, but need to make sure athletes and international students are not dropped under 12.

UAS – yes, and their athletes will be OK. Need to talk more about overrides.

Instructor approval code in SFAREGS? Would they be dropped regardless of the override?

KPC: many students get instructor signature and it's not reflected in SFASRPO.

Since most overrides in SFAREGS are done close to class start dates and add/drop deadline, this should not be an issue. This process will be run after spring term grading for fall term classes (for example). Once those students who have not met prereqs are dropped in May, most overrides are done in SFASRPO.

Mat-Su: accuplacer students? For those cases when banner can't add? Lora: SFASRPO override will be given by the dept or advisor.

Mae: need to make sure the students who are being dropped are notified.

Approved for BST provided athlete and international students concerns are addressed.

2. Register/Add/Drop classes layout in UAOnline (UAS)

Students call with registration problems: they don't realize they need to change the term. Suggest to highlight or move the term on the page to make more prominent.

Although this is a concern, it's not very frequently that we have to deal with it. Also with eventual transition to XE we might be better off using resources elsewhere.

All agreed.

3. Webinar "What's New in Banner Registration: Reg Planning and Degree Works Integration"

Brandon – liked 98%. Concern: ability for faculty to register students. Should be able to turn off.

General release in December. Another HR module complete in XE is being sandboxed shortly.

HR will be data partner on HR side

It will be a big undertaking, so we need to be careful about choosing the time for the reg upgrade.

All agreed that it's better to have another couple of modules done in XE before undertaking registration.

4. TR 292 – Waitlist Process (assignment? Updates?)

Cancel the TR for now since we are moving towards common calendar.

In the future, we will still need to address the issue of students not being able to change from WL to registration online after notifications are turned off. We may be able then to address it by shortening the notification window from 48 to 24 hrs, etc., since all campuses will be on the same calendar.

5. TR 185 – Reg Access for Non-Degree Seeking students (Russell ideas to the team)

The menu was alphabetized 3 years ago. Jane wanted to make sure the decision to change order was an informed one, since the registrars requested alphabetizing earlier.

LRGP right now under "Take a class".

OK by all to continue from here.

6. TR 179 – Correct Prereq Message not displayed to faculty (Possibly changing the TR? Update)

Ideas Russell considered previously turned out too ambitious for the given workload.

Will continue working the TR as is.

7. TR 97 - View Holds (status?)

LRGP no movement. Joe needs to make a change.

8. Add Summer 2015 to Schedule Planner in LRGP (and remove Fall 2014)
