RE: Notification of Public Records Requests
RFP to Lease or Purchase Land, Tract 1, U-Med Professional Park Subdivision

The Land Management Office has received a public records requests for the July 19, 2022 protest. Since this is a protest of the solicitation rather than a protest of a contract award, the University's obligation under AS 14.40.367 (to keep the names of potential offerors confidential until after the notice of intent to make a contract award) will remain applicable while the University resolves the protest. It may or may not prove feasible to redact sufficient information from the protest itself to fulfill the purposes of the statute, so the University is carefully considering its response to the public record request. If anything is produced in response to the request, it will be shared with all interested parties. However, there is no opportunity for interested parties to provide their opinions about the merits of a protest. It is the University's responsibility to review the protest, evaluate its merits, and apply the law accordingly.

As previously stated in the July 21 memo notifying all interested parties of the protest filing, the solicitation process has been stayed until the decision on the protest is issued, which will include an amended submission deadline, with adequate time added to ensure that interested parties can address any changes to solicitation terms which may be included in the decision.
